"Angels Bridging Gaps Inc" is an Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) and Other Disabilities parent/caregiver support organization dedicated to helping families and individuals affected by varying levels of ASD ranging from Autism to Aspergers, along with other disabilities by providing emotional support, education, socialization, and to serve as a resource to inform caregivers of community services, activities, programs, and available treatment options – both local regional, and national. As of April 6th, 2021, we have officially launched our adults with disabilities day program called "ABGworks Inc." Serving the underserved population of young adults with disabilities age 18 and up. Most of whom would be left sitting at home feeling disconnected from the world around them and unmotivated to find their direction in life. Our program is firmly based on three basic principles that help empower the individual through Enrichment, Employment, and Resources. A special Park for a Special Community By Christina Chiarillo, Editor




Have you ever heard of Field of Dreams? It's a park in West Melbourne that caters to the special needs community. It has fields, playgrounds, pavilions, and sensory equipment that are all handicap accessible and designed to provide a safe and fun environment for children and adults with disabilities.

Field of Dreams was created by Jim Papp, a local resident who wanted to transform an old park that was not suitable for his son with special needs. He raised funds and donations to renovate the park and make it a place where everyone can enjoy. In 2018, the city of West Melbourne took over the park and hired Ivy Gonzalez as the Special Populations Coordinator.

Ivy is in charge of organizing and coordinating special recreation events and programs for the park. She works with other groups and organizations, such as Angels Bridging Gaps, to co-host monthly events that support the special needs community. Some of the events include dances, holiday parties, sensory activities, and sports. Ivy says that these events are free of charge for the special needs community and that they are very popular and well-attended.

Ivy has a lot of experience in working with people with disabilities. She has been in the field of therapeutic recreation for over 25 years, mostly with adults with dementia. She moved to Merritt Island from Orlando a few years ago and saw the posting for her current position. She says that she loves her job and that she is passionate about providing quality programs and services for the special needs community.
