Anna serves as an Ambassador for the Lives Amplified Foundation, is part of the International Environment Awareness Committee under the Eurasia Afro Chamber of Commerce and 100 Voices for the Planet, both affiliated with the United Nations. As a published book author, her storytelling extends beyond the canvas, adding another layer to her creative work.

Her ongoing environmental series features photographs of untouched landscapes printed on recycled boards, overlayed with plastic trash collected from beaches, especially in Bali. These fragments are often shaped into hearts or bottles and preserved in resin, creating stark and powerful contrasts between the beauty of nature and the waste we leave behind. The result is visually pleasing yet deeply unsettling, inviting reflection on pollution and calling for urgent environmental awareness and action.

A true global citizen, Anna's creative journey spans four continents, with exhibitions at high-profile venues and events including the Venice Biennale, Cannes Film Festival, and Times Square in New York. When she's not exhibiting worldwide, she splits her time between Bali, Barcelona, and London. Her recent collaborations range from film institutions and hospitality to political summits and UN-affiliated forums, reinforcing her voice as a cultural force driving impact through art.





Video Mapping

Anna regularly uses video mapping as a means to display her artwork. One of her biggest projects included a 15 minute video display on the façade of SiR Victor Hotel in Barcelona, along with a custom made animation made specifically for the venue. This projection technique turned complex objects, often irregularly shaped, into a display surface for video projection and added extra dimensions, optical illusions, and movement onto previously static objects.





Unicorn Ink x Stephen Wayda

Anna Dogadkina's creative friendship with legendary photographer Stephen Wayda began in Bali in 2019 and became a pivotal moment in her photography journey. United by their passion for the female form, their collaboration centered on the art of nude photography, balancing elegance, vulnerability, and strength. Under Stephen's mentorship, Anna refined her ability to create images that are both evocative and empowering.

Stephen Wayda, one of the most published photographers in Playboy history and known for his iconic portraits of '90s celebrities, was once described by Hugh Hefner as someone whose work "helped change the way the world looks at women." He was also the exclusive photographer for Pamela Anderson and captured Donald Trump.

Their upcoming collaboration will fuse Stephen's classic celebrity portraits with Anna's signature collage style, blending old Hollywood glamour with bold, contemporary storytelling.
