ABOUT THE PROJECT

This collaboration seeks to protect the heritage and ancient knowledge of the Yawanawa, who are at risk, with only around 1,600 individuals remaining in the Amazon. Through cacao—a revered Amazonian medicine on the verge of being lost in Brazil—we aim to contribute to a sustainable economy and safeguard their cultural legacy.

WHY CACAO?

Cacao is an ancient Amazonian plant with powerful medicinal and cultural significance. By reintroducing it, we can both regenerate the rainforest and provide economic opportunity, especially for Yawanawa women, who will lead in cacao cultivation, processing, and healing ceremonies.
