Rules and Regulation of the San Pedro Town Council ("SPTC") Market

1. The market will be located at the Saca Chispas Stadium. The market will operate between the hours of 6am – 5pm and will operate on the dates set by the San Pedro Town Council.
2. Vendors must notify the market manager no later than 24 hours before market time if they will be absent for that market day.
3. No selling is permitted before or after the official operating time, as announced by the market manager.
4. Products not specifically identified must be pre-approved by the market management.
5. All applicable food safety regulations, must be adhered to at all times.
6. All stall spaces must be clean and any refuse removed at the end of each market day.
7. All vendors must ensure that everyone around their stall spaces adhere to the Quarantine Act regulations and guidelines.
8. Each vendor will be responsible for all equipment and supplies for the setup of a booth. Displays should be constructed in such a way that they do not block customer walkways nor pose any other hazard to customers.
9. Vendors are required to keep their market space neat and clear of obstacles, litter and debris.
10. No smoking or firearms are permitted at the market.
11. No hawking, proselytizing or amplified music is permitted at the market.
12. All products offered for sale must be of good quality and condition. The Market manager reserves the right to direct any inferior goods be removed from display. Failure to remove products deemed inferior will be reported to the market’s governing body and may result in loss of market privileges
13. Vendors are responsible for the actions of their representatives, employees or agents.
14. All complaints must be addressed in writing to the Market Manager.
