

In the meantime, check out the pictures taken at camp on the next page!







FINANCIAL REPORT Ending June 30, 2022

a. Offering Envelopes

- i) For the month, over budget at 124.5% (\$13,200 vs \$10,601).
- ii) Year-to-date, on budget at 99.8% (\$65,814 vs \$65,958).

b. Total Income

- i) For the month, over budget at 126.0% (\$16,671 vs \$13,226).
- ii) **Year-to-date,** on budget at 100.2% (\$86,231 vs \$86,052).

c. Expenses

- i) For the month, on budget at 99.5% (\$16,609 vs \$16,698).
- ii) Year-to-date, slightly over budget at 101.7% (\$96,654 vs \$95,006).
- d. **Net Operating Income** (Total Income minus Expenses)
 - i) For the month, a surplus of \$62 vs the expected loss of \$3,473.
 - ii) Year-to-date, a loss of \$10,423 vs the expected loss of \$8,955.

e. **Checking balance**

- i) **Balance at Month-end** is \$14,535.
- ii) Previous Month-end balance was \$14,451.

f. Comments

i) On paper, June looks very good. Member Offerings exceeded budget by a significant amount. However, this was because a member contributed their offering in a lump sum, rather than over several months. The reality is we continue to be under budget in our Member offerings and overall income, regardless of what the graph below suggests.

News from the Endowment Fund Board

The Endowment Fund Board would like to share some wonderful news with the congregation. In May, the Board awarded \$1500 scholarships to two outstanding applicants from Pacific Lutheran Theological Seminary: Steven Namburi and Charbel Zgheib. Then, by completing required forms, the Board secured matching funds through the Congregational Partners in Education Award Program.

Overnight, Faith's \$3000 in scholarships awarded for the 2022-2023 school year had turned into \$6000, and those two seminarians had received extra encouragement in their quest to follow God's calling. Thanks be to God!

Coincidentally, both scholarship recipients are international students. Steven Namburi is a fifth-generation Christian from India. His Dalit (untouchable) ancestor converted from Hinduism to Christianity. Thanks to God's work through missionaries, the Dalits have been lifted from inhumane atrocities to hopeful opportunities. Now on the path to become an ordained ELCA pastor, Steven asserts, "I will strive to serve the lost, the least, and the last for the rest of my life."

Born in Lebanon, Charbel Zgheib grew up in a land suffering from civil war. In his adult years, Charbel has had several unique experiences including volunteering at a Christian radio station and serving as a social worker who brought support to foreign inmates in a Lebanese prison. After taking PLTS courses online while still in Lebanon, Charbel moved to California in 2021 to continue his seminary education. Now he is on internship.

What a joyful privilege it is for the Faith family to be able to award scholarships to deserving students! Through the years, donations to the scholarship funds of the Endowment Fund Board have made such scholarships possible. May we continue to support this worthwhile endeavor.
