FINANCIAL REPORT Ending March 31, 2022

a. Offering Envelopes

- i) For the month, significantly under budget at 85.6% (\$10,284 vs \$12,013).
- ii) Year-to-date, well under budget at 88.3% (\$20,519 vs \$23,248).

b. Total Income

- i) For the month, significantly below budget at 82.6% (\$11,943 vs \$14,457).
- ii) Year-to-date, well below budget at 88.5% (\$24,860 vs \$28,094).

c. Expenses

- i) For the month, under budget at 94.9% (\$14,617 vs \$15,410).
- ii) Year-to-date, slightly above budget at 102.8% (\$32,609 vs \$31,721).
- d. Net Operating Income (Total Income minus Expenses)
 - i) For the month, a loss of \$2,673 vs the expected loss of \$953.
 - ii) Year-to-date, a significant loss of \$7,749 vs the expected loss of \$3,627.

e. **Checking balance**

- i) Balance at Month-end is \$117,191, due to the addition of \$100,000 from the new loan.
- ii) Previous Month-end balance was \$20,045.

f. **Comments**

- i) Offerings for February continue to be well below expectations. This is especially concerning as the budgeted income was based on last year's Actuals, so we have some work to do.
- ii) Our checking account balance is high due to the receipt of the \$100,000 new loan proceeds in February. This will be normalized in the March Financials which will reflect the Thrivent Mortgage payoff and the transfer of the remaining Loan proceeds to the Long Term Property account, from which we'll pay for the various improvements to be done.

BTV CLEAN UP CREW

With all of the anti-government, anti-LGBTQ, anti-abortion, anti-immigrant and other hate groups out there today, there is a positive side. In July 2019, a group in Burlington, Vermont was organized called the *BTV Clean Up Crew*, motivated to confront hate and extremism in their community.

When a hate group posts flyers and stickers in their area, this group removes those flyers and stickers and other roadside trash in their community. The group's fundraising model tallies the number of hate stickers they have removed, then ask for donations from Facebook followers who pledge a monetary amount per sticker to a local nonprofit of the Crew's choosing, so the more stickers hate groups post in their area, the larger the donation to local progressive organizations.

This is a clean-up organization model that can be adopted by progressive churches, civic organizations, colleges and other institutions as a counter to all the negative action and propaganda of extremist groups. Domestic terrorism and intimidation must be brought to an end, because it is dividing the country, to the point that nobody trusts anyone, government, banks, teachers, etc.

Group members do not alert the police or local media to the flyers and stickers, but quietly remove them along with other types of trash. If you are interested in creating such a group, the BTV Clean Up Crew recommends making a strong distinction between the bigotry espoused and politics, but rather recognize it for what it is.






