Dear faithful friends and fellow children of God: We can't spell "YOUth education" without "YOU"!

Because this is so, so important, I am repeating last month's plea: we need Sunday School Teachers!

Here is the situation, we would all like to make a welcoming, instructive, and inviting community for all generations to enjoy. In particular, Faith's education team is making an intentional effort to recruit, train, and qualify Sunday School volunteers so that we may begin Sunday School on August 20, the week after the Blessing of the Backpacks! Here is what we have: we were awarded a \$1000 grant from the synod to cover fingerprint and background checks for our teachers, making our program certified with CA law AB506. We have a prepared, full curriculum, complete with videos, activities, and lesson plans, making it simple and fun for our volunteers to step into their teacher's shoes and not have to reinvent the wheel. All we need is you!




Our goal is to have 10 people (at least) involved to have a healthy and sustainable team that can rotate throughout the month. There are different ways to help in three roles: Teacher, Assistant, and Backup. Teachers prepare by familiarizing themselves with the pre-prepared lessons which are ready for you in the curriculum. Assistants compliment the teacher by aiding in activities the teachers have explained, as well as providing additional adult presence. Backups would be folks who are oriented in the program but won't necessarily be on the regular schedule - as the name implies if an assistant can't make it some


Sunday, we can have backups to fill that place and maintain our necessary two adults per class policy. We need more volunteers in all three of these crucial roles.

I personally invite anyone who has an inkling of God's call to help teach our youth to please contact Amy Sinclair (council president and education chair) or me. We need you and are eager to have a conversation with you about what our Sunday School program is and how to grow it. Please prayerfully consider joining the team and thank you in advance for making this essential ministry possible!

Here are some important updates from the Church Council.

We need a Treasurer. The Church Council is currently looking for a new church Treasurer since our current treasurer, Mike McGavran, is retiring at the end of July. We have reached out to congregation members directly and we are still searching. If you have any interest in the position or any ideas for someone who might be able to do this, please contact the council president, Amy Sinclair at 562-714-0707. Right now, our office administrator, Lynn Bennett is performing most of the daily and weekly tasks as an assistant to the Treasurer. She is willing to continue to do these tasks, but we need a Treasurer who can attend church council meetings and be responsible for the Treasurer duties. We also currently have a bookkeeper and we will continue to do the bookkeeping duties. Further information will be forthcoming. <u>Sound System Project:</u> The church Sanctuary Sound System Upgrade Project is moving along. Recently about 17 requests for proposals/bids, were sent out to sound system engineering companies. The leader of the sound system project, Sarge Hunter, will be at church to host open house; time for company representatives and engineers to come and see our system and ask questions. This will take place on July 13th, 2023.

<u>Park – Land Sale</u>: Regarding the sale of our land to the city for a park behind our property, there is no real update at this time but the city is working with the state and their own internal departments to get things moving along. We were told that there might be a community question and answer event in early Fall to discuss the park project further. This event would be open to residents of Menifee as well as congregation members.

FINANCIAL REPORT Ending May 31, 2023

1. Comments

- a. This month's Member giving was below budget for the month, but we are still over budget year-to-date.
- b. Keep in mind that being over budget doesn't mean we have a surplus, as the budget reflects an overall deficit of over \$31,000. We need to continue to give faithfully!
- c. Our expenses were higher than budget for the month, mostly due to "catch-up" billings from 2 of our vendors who overlooked invoicing us in the last few months.



2. Financials Review

a. Offering Envelopes

- i) For the month, under budget at 86.2% (\$10,419 vs \$12,087).
- ii) Year-to-date, over budget at 110.0% (\$57,857 vs \$52,614).

b. Total Income

- i) For the month, under budget at 90.7% (\$12,793 vs \$14,101).
- ii) Year-to-date, over budget at 109.9% (\$83.280 vs \$75,811).

c. Expenses

- i) For the month, over budget at 112.2% (\$18,927 vs \$16,867).
- ii) Year-to-date, slightly over budget at 103.2% (\$84,623 vs \$81,901).
- d. Net Operating Income (Total Income minus Expenses)
 - i) For the month, a loss of \$6,134 vs the expected loss of \$2,766.
 - ii) Year-to-date, a loss of \$1,343 vs the expected loss of \$6,090.

TIME FOR A CHANGE

This will be my last Forecaster article as your Treasurer. I've been serving in this capacity, either officially or unofficially, for the past several years. Now, circumstances make it necessary for me to step away from this role, and let someone else pick up this Council responsibility. Although I will no longer be on Council, I intend to continue as Chair of the Finance Committee for the time being, but am unable to continue as Treasurer as well. I will also continue to work on special projects, such as the Park project (the land sale to the City).

During my time as Treasurer, we've developed many processes to standardize and simplify the job, including transferring many of the routine aspects to our Office Manager, Lynn Bennett. It's my hope that one of our newer members is ready to take over the remaining Treasurer duties, and I'm happy to assist during the transition. It's been my honor to serve as your Treasurer.


