

Last month I said "Baseball, did I hear baseball"? Well, baseball came and it was a blast. See photos below, Faith shirts and all!



FINANCIAL REPORT

June 30, 2024

1. Comments

- a. Member giving was outstanding this month, the best since last December. As a result, we are on budget for the year-to-date! And, expenses for the year are nicely below budget. As a result, our Net Operating Income shows a surplus year-to-date, instead of the projected modest loss so far. We are a FAITHful congregation!
- b. This month, we were able to transfer \$8,616 to the New Pastor Reserve Fund, by charging our Pastoral Expense categories to the full budgeted amount.
- c. As a reminder, Pastor Shane is available to provide Pastoral Care to our congregation during our transition. If you would like to talk with him, just call the Church Office and Lynn will get you connected.



2. Financials Review

- a. **Offering Envelopes**
 - i) **For the month**, significantly above budget at 132% (\$17,721 vs \$13,422).
 - ii) **Year-to-date**, on budget at 100.6% (\$75,096 vs \$74,629).
- b. **Total Income**
 - i) **For the month**, well above budget at 127.4% (\$19,757 vs \$15,514).
 - ii) **Year-to-date**, on budget at 99.6% (\$110,468 vs \$110,971).
- c. **Expenses**
 - i) **For the month**, on budget at 99.5% (\$17,932 vs \$18,031).
 - ii) **Year-to-date**, under budget at 93.2% (\$104,618 vs \$112,237).
- d. **Net Operating Income** (Total Income minus Expenses)
 - i) **For the month**, a surplus of \$1,824 vs the expected loss of \$2,518.
 - ii) **Year-to-date**, a surplus of \$5,850 vs the expected loss of \$1,266.
- e. **Checking balance**
 - i) **Balance at Month-end** is \$9,294.
 - ii) **Previous Month-end balance** was \$7,499.




