- Feel free to wave to your friends on either side of your car and then call them up after to wish them joyous Christmas wishes.
- If you have jumper cables, please bring them to help others, if needed.

Our service will include some of our favorite Christmas Eve Hymns; you will find the lyrics attached to this letter. Please bring the lyrics to the service so that you can sing along in your cars. Also, at the end of the service when we sing "Silent Night" we encourage you to bring a battery-powered electric candle to light. Those with smart phones may choose to download a free "candle" app.
