### STIMULUS CHECKS – HERE'S A THOUGHT....

Many of us have already received our Stimulus checks or will shortly. For some, this will be an important addition to limited finances. However, for those whose income has not been materially affected by the Pandemic, these checks are like a bonus, just waiting for something to spend it on.

If these checks are a bonus for you, here's a thought about how you might spend some of it. Your Council has begun making a list of important Property expenses likely over the next 12-24 months. While we have some reserves for such purposes, we suspect we'll need more than what we have now.

The list includes some exterior painting to help preserve our aging wood structures, likely roof resurfacing/replacement for the flat roof areas, parking lot repair/resurfacing/painting, and some possible furnace repairs/replacement. There are probably more items to add to the list.

So, if your Stimulus check is more of a bonus than a necessity, you might consider donating 10%, 25%, 50% (or more!) of that amount to build up our Property reserves. Just add "Property Reserves" to your check's memo line. Thanks for your consideration!

Council had their first council meeting on February 22<sup>nd</sup>. Our Council approved we can now have meetings in the Fellowship Hall with the following guidelines. Requests need to be approved by either Executive Council or the full Council and scheduled in advance with our Church Office Administrator. The group size cannot exceed 8 people and upon arrival the group leader will confirm each person is fever free. Remember that everyone must wear face masks. The named group leader is responsible for insuring compliance with these guidelines and making sure all surfaces are sanitized before and after the meeting.

Our Council is also revisiting our opening In-Church Services and plans to be open very soon. We are taking into consideration the right date to open our church with our Worship and Music Committee reviewing and updating our Protocols for In-Person Worship. We want to have the safest opportunities and considerations to all. This would also give us more time to have more members fully vaccinated. The vaccines are the best news we can hope for.

Council is looking at the costs for long-term property maintenance and repairs, as we have several expensive projects that will need attention soon.

Our Outreach Committee walked around our church neighborhood and passed out Easter Door Hangers last week. We are still using our Thrivent cards to donate food to Menifee Valley Community Cupboard.

We have a Eucharistic Ministry Training class with Pastor John scheduled for May 27<sup>th</sup>. Please let us know if you would like to attend - all are welcome.

Our next Council Meeting will be held on April 26<sup>th</sup> at 1:00 and we want to remind you that our meetings are open to visitors.

## FINANCIAL REPORT Ending February 28, 2021

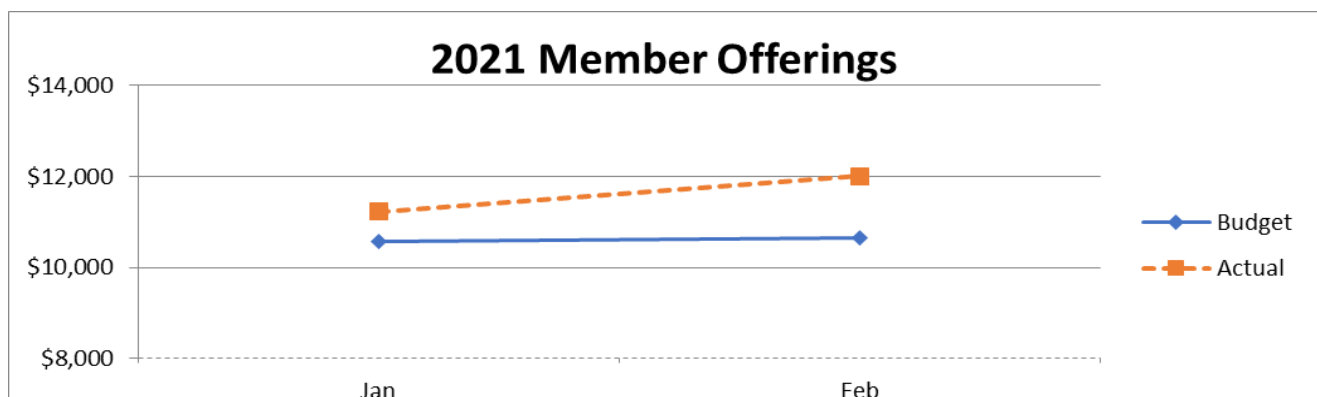
- a. **Offering Envelopes**
  - i) **For the month**, we are above budget at 112.8% (\$12,013 vs \$10,646).
  - ii) **Year-to-date**, we are above budget at 109.5% (\$29,169 vs \$21,244).
- b. **Total Income**
  - i) **For the month**, above budget at 111.9% (\$14,517 vs \$12,976).
  - ii) **Year-to-date**, significantly above budget at 128.5% (\$33,075 vs \$25,739).
- c. **Expenses**
  - i) **For the month**, under budget at 91.9% (\$14,162 vs \$15,411).
  - ii) **Year-to-date**, under budget at 95.3% (\$29,789 vs \$31,262).
- d. **Net Operating Income** (Total Income minus Expenses)
  - i) **For the month**, much better than expected with a small profit of \$355, vs. the expected loss of \$2,435.
  - ii) **Year-to-date**, much better than expected with a profit of \$3,287, vs. the expected loss of \$5,523.
- e. **Checking balance**
  - i) **Balance at Month-end** is \$19,135.
  - ii) **Previous Month-end balance** was \$18,782.

### What this means:

- Our 2021 budgeted income for Jan-Sept is based on 85% of 2020 Actuals. The good news is that we may have been too conservative in that estimate, as we've exceeded budget for both January and February.
- Total Income was substantially above budget due to a \$5,000 Special Offering gift from a deceased member.
- With Expenses below budget (mostly Office and Property), the net result (Net Operating Income) was a profit rather than the expected loss.

### How we are doing:

We've started 2021 ahead of budget. Let's keep it that way! Don't forget your Lenten and Easter offerings. **Thanks for your faithfulness.**
