Spotlight on Ministry: Hymn Planners Spiritual Gifts: Administration, Music and Knowledge Giving Generously of themselves to the Glory of God!

Hymn planning is a subgroup of the Worship & Music Ministry dedicated to helping Pastor Barton choose the hymns for each

worship service. Anyone in the congregation is welcome to join us at our meetings on Zoom – once, occasionally or regularly. (Our next meeting is Monday, March 15th at 9:00 am.)

We meet every four to five weeks to choose hymns guided by suggestions from <u>Sundays and Seasons</u>, a worship resource provided by the ELCA. Many of the hymns suggested in this resource are unfamiliar to our congregation, so we must come up with alternative possibilities that are still in keeping with the lessons and themes of each particular Sunday. We also try to incorporate hymn requests from congregational members if we have any. Feel free to browse through the hymnals you've received at Drive-In Worship and send a request to the church office or Pastor.

The hardest part of our search is trying to find a suitable recorded version that we can play over the radio broadcast. Sometimes many of these online hymns that match the lyrics and melodies in our hymnals are neither comprehensible nor well "performed" musically. Sometimes we find a soloist who is wonderful, but with whom it is not always easy to sing along. Listening to such a version can be just as much a blessing as singing along. This process can be a bit time-consuming. What you've heard to date are the best options we've found so far for the hymns we've used.

We all firmly believe that music is one of the ways we are blessed and that God speaks to us as we worship. Hymns must be chosen with care and prayer. It is our prayer that you are blessed by the hymns we choose every Sunday in worship. It is an ongoing adventure to maintain the richness of our musical heritage under the extraordinary circumstances of worshipping in our cars via the radio. Thank you for your attendance and your understanding. Come to Drive-In Worship and sing your hearts out in your cars!!

FINANCIAL REPORT

Ending January 31, 2021

a. Offering Envelopes

- i) For the month, we are above budget at 106.1% (\$11,235 vs \$10,589).
- ii) Year-to-date, we are above budget at 106.1% (\$11,235 vs \$10,589).

b. Total Income

- i) For the month, significantly above budget at 145.4% (\$18,558 vs \$12,763).
- ii) Year-to-date, significantly above budget at 145.4% (\$18,558 vs \$12,763).

c. <u>Expenses</u>

- i) For the month, just under budget at 98.6% (\$15,627 vs \$15,851).
- ii) Year-to-date, just under budget at 98.6% (\$15,627 vs \$15,851).
- d. Net Operating Income (Total Income minus Expenses)
 - i) For the month, much better than expected with a profit of \$2,931, vs. the expected loss of \$3,088.
 - ii) **Year-to-date**, much better than expected with a profit of \$2,931, vs. the expected loss of \$3,088.

e. Checking balance

- i) Balance at Month-end is \$18,782.
- ii) Previous Month-end balance was \$15,890.

What this means:

- In 2020, our overall average giving was just over 91% of Budget, due in large part to the pandemic and the loss of several members last year. As a result, our 2021 budgeted income for Jan-Sept is based on just 85% of 2020 Actuals. It's a hopeful sign to see Offering Envelope giving exceed budget for January.
- Total Income was substantially above budget due to a \$5,000 Special Offering gift from a deceased member.
- With Expenses essentially on budget, the net result (Net Operating Income) was a profit rather than the expected loss.

How we are doing:

We've started 2021 slightly ahead of budget. **Thanks for your faithfulness.** Let's keep it that way! Don't forget your Lenten and Easter offerings.

Dear Women of Faith,

It is hard to realize that we are already in the season of Lent. We are now focusing on the promise that, "God shows God's love for us in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us." (Romans 5:8)

The third session of our four-part Bible Study series **"Journey with Angels"** is found in the March issue of ******Gather* magazine. We will study the scriptures to learn how angels enter our lives during times of loneliness, abandonment, and sorrow, and give us Holy Comfort.

We continue with two Circles. Lydia – Bea Olsen, Chair – met on February 18th. Three members gathered in person, outside at church, and shared a meaningful study on "Turnaround Angels" who influence people to make positive changes in their lives. The study was led by Bea Olsen. Mary Circle – Pat Olson, Chair – met February 10th on Zoom. Ten members shared an excellent and thought-provoking lesson led by Joanne McGavran, following the same theme. **All women of Faith are included in W-ELCA. You can belong to more than one Circle – try us out!**

Our W-ELCA Board has been brainstorming ideas that might make our meetings more accessible to all. One idea is to reactivate the Elizabeth Circle, a.k.a the **"Brown Bag Circle"**, who originally met at 6:00pm. Everyone brought a "brown bag" and ate supper together before the study began. 3:00pm was their most recent meeting time, but they could be scheduled at any time with or without the "brown bag". We also tossed around a **Zoom "Pajama Circle"**, which could work at night or in the morning, and **Bible Study "Buddies"** for those not comfortable with Zoom or meeting at church. This would be **one-on-one by phone**, set at any time of any day, very flexible, and determined by the two "Buddies". Changing our General Meetings (once we can meet safely) from weekdays to Saturdays is a definite possibility. Hopefully, this would enable women who work outside the home and mothers of young children to attend. **More ideas would be appreciated!** Do give this some prayerful thought and share YOUR ideas with us.
