

Dear faithful friends and fellow children of God:

Peace and Conflict. I write to you in another time of unwelcome chaos centering around the escalating conflict in Ukraine. Though the conflict is half a world away, I'm sure it is as concerning to many of you as it is to me. The reckless abandonment of common sense and warmongering actions of the Russian leadership is dumbfoundingly irrational and (it goes without saying) dangerous. We all, as global citizens, are having our own set of emotions right now: fear, confusion, anger, numbness, apathy, and empathy. As for the

Ukrainian people, we might not have known much about Ukraine or its people before the build-up to this conflict, but we know they are people and that they are living through a time of immense turmoil and fear. May we always keep the Ukrainian people and all innocent peoples in the path of war and conflict at the center of our prayers for hope and peace.

It is hard to fathom how this came about, the rise of yet another potential war that could embroil forces from across the globe and endanger untold lives. We don't know what will happen with this event and we don't know what impacts it will have for our country and our individual lives, particularly so close to its outbreak. It is in these times, when there is so much uncertainty and when our minds and realities cannot grasp the seemingly ungraspable events of the world, it is now that we find our answers and guidance in God.

God is the source of wisdom beyond our comprehension and peace that passes our understanding. When the small-scoped, shortsighted selfishness of the world seeks to take control, it is at that moment we open ourselves to God, turning to Christ's lessons and example, and to the Holy Spirit's leadings. As Jesus said:

"Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid." ~John 14:27~

Jesus gives us the promise of peace, a peace that no weapon, no army, no war can ever take away from us. Christ has instilled in us God's divine peace, it is with us wherever we are whether in a warzone or in the comfort of our home. It is Christ's peace that we share every Sunday worship, every time we break bread together, every time we do an act of kindness for another person.

Christ's peace is the light in the darkness of uncertainty and conflict. This peace and the desire for it to manifest around us is what connects us all, all of the rational, humane peoples all over the world. Peace is what we look for, what we pray for, along with all who are experiencing the absence of it. Take courage, keep the faith, hold on to God's promise of hope and peace.

So, until we see each other again: "May the Lord bless you and keep you; may the Lord make his face shine on you and be gracious to you; may the Lord turn his face toward you and give you peace." (Numbers 6:24-26).

FINANCIAL REPORT

Ending December 31, 2021

a. Offering Envelopes

- i) For the month, under budget at 91.1% (\$10,235 vs \$11,235).
- ii) Year-to-date, same.

b. Total Income

- i) For the month, below budget at 94.7% (\$12,917 vs \$13,637).
- ii) Year-to-date, same.

c. **Expenses**

- i) For the month, over budget at 110.3% (\$17,993 vs \$16,311).
- ii) Year-to-date, same.
- d. Net Operating Income (Total Income minus Expenses)
 - i) For the month, a loss of \$5,076 vs. the expected loss of \$2,674.
 - ii) Year-to-date, same.

e. Checking balance

- i) Balance at Month-end is \$20,045.
- ii) Previous Month-end balance was \$24,934.

f. Comments

- i) While we finished 2021 well ahead of budget, the new year start is disappointing. The budgeted income was based on last year's Actuals and we are behind those as we start the year.
- ii) Higher expenses are due mostly to a booking error for Staff Bonuses, which will be corrected in February, and unbilled expenses from the prior year that were billed and paid in January.

Greetings, dear women of Faith!

March is the start of the Lenten season. A time to focus on the promise, "God shows God's love for us in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us." (Romans 5:8)

The W-ELCA Board met on Wednesday, February 16th. Plans were discussed and made for our March 17 general meeting. The proposed 2022 budget was approved and will be presented at our general meeting. The Prayer Partners were discussed to see if we would like to have that project this year.

Continuing with our winter Bible study in March, we will be studying part three "Eternal life in the Gospel of John". In the fourth Gospel Jesus uses the expression "eternal life" to talk about what he called the "kingdom of God" in the other Gospels. We will look at some popular passages, including John 3:16 and the story of Jesus and the woman at the well to discover how our lives can be marked by love and purpose.


We will gather on Tuesday, March 22nd, in person at Church at 10:00-11:00am.
