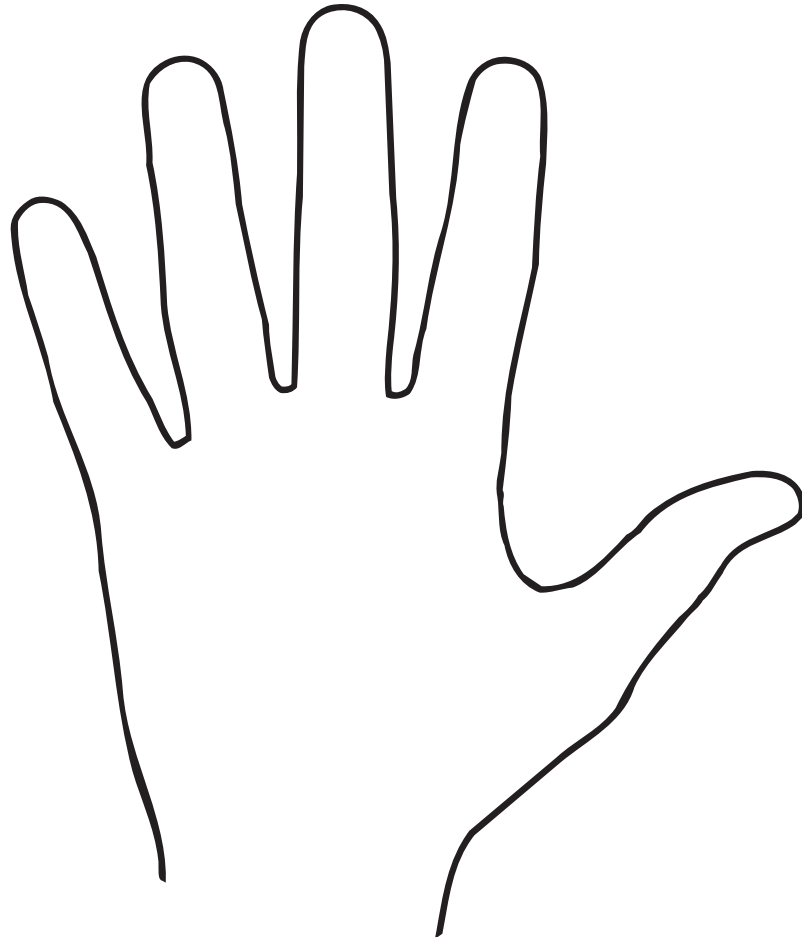


Loving Our Neighbor

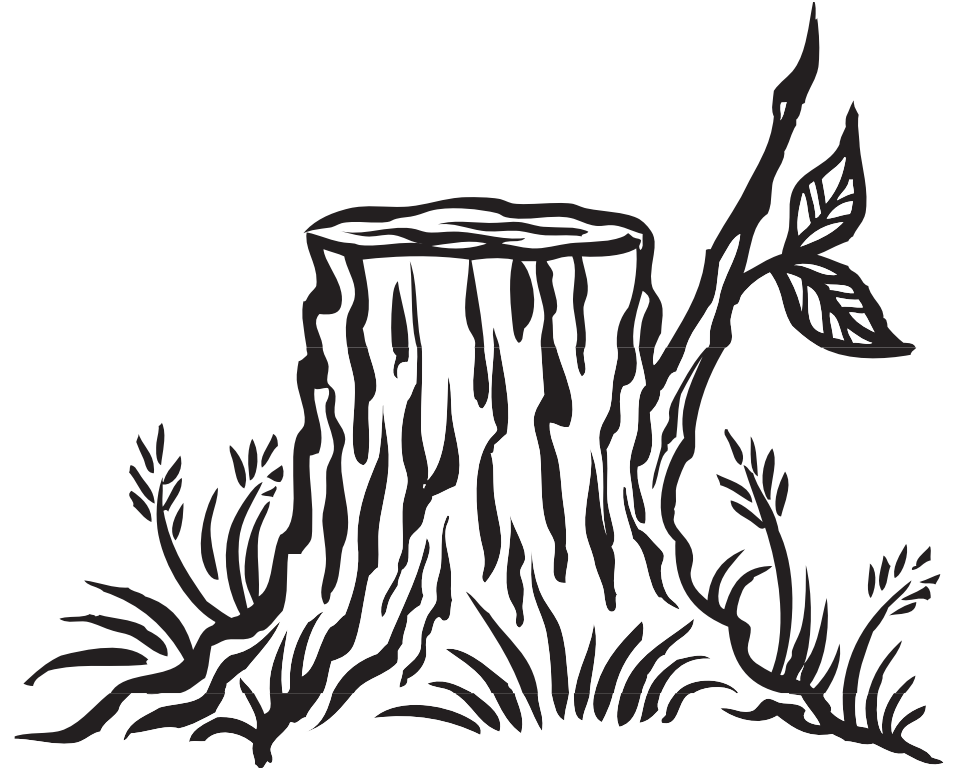

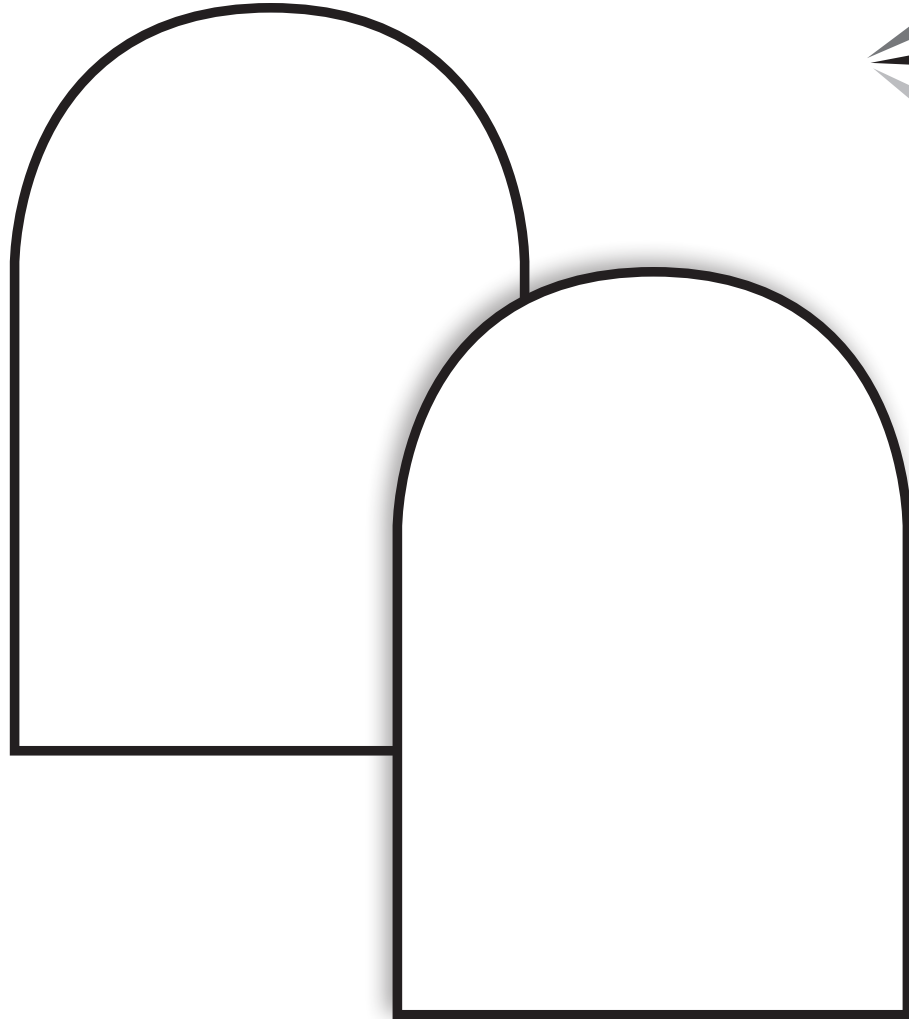


Ten Down to One
