Scriptural Stations of the Cross:

1. Jesus in the Garden of Gethsemane **Matthew 26:36-38 / Luke 22:40-46**
2. Jesus is betrayed by Judas and arrested **Matthew 26:47-50 / John 18:1-3**
3. Jesus is condemned by the Sanhedrin **Matthew 26:57-68, 27:1-2**
4. Jesus is denied by Peter **Matthew 26:69-75**
5. Jesus is judged by Pilate **John 19:4-16**
6. Jesus is scourged and crowned with thorns **Mark 15:15-20**
7. Jesus takes up his cross **John 19:16-17**
8. Jesus is helped by Simon to carry his cross **Mark 15:21 / Luke 23:26**
9. Jesus meets the women of Jerusalem **Luke 23:27-31**
10. Jesus is crucified **Mark 15:25**
11. Jesus promises his kingdom to the good thief **Luke 23:39-43**
12. Jesus entrusts Mary and John to each other **John 19:25-27**
13. Jesus dies on the cross **Mark 15:33-39 / John 19:30 / Luke 23:46**
14. Jesus is laid in the tomb. **Matthew 27:57-61 / Luke 23:53-54**

Traditional Stations of the Cross:

1. Christ condemned to death;
2. The cross is laid upon him;
3. His first fall;
4. He meets His Blessed Mother;
5. Simon of Cyrene is made to bear the cross;
6. Christ's face is wiped by Veronica;
7. His second fall;
8. He meets the women of Jerusalem;
9. His third fall;
10. He is stripped of His garments;
11. His crucifixion;
12. His death on the cross;
13. His body is taken down from the cross; and
14. He is laid in the tomb.

*Sometimes included in the Stations is the Resurrection which is considered the 15th Station.

New Stations of the Cross:

1. Jesus institutes the Eucharist
2. Jesus prays in Gethsemane
3. Jesus before the Sanhedrin
4. Jesus is scourged and crowned with thorns
5. Jesus carries the cross to Calvary

6. Jesus falls under the weight of the cross
7. Jesus is helped by Simon of Cyrene
8. Jesus meets the pious women of Jerusalem
9. Jesus is nailed on the cross
10. Jesus promises Heaven to the repentant thief
11. Jesus entrusts Mary and John to each other
12. Jesus suffers and dies on the cross
13. Jesus is taken down from the cross, and is laid in the tomb
14. Jesus rises from the dead

Way of the Resurrection/ Way of Light:

- 1) Jesus is raised from the dead
- 2) The finding of the empty tomb
- 3) Mary Magdalene meets the risen Jesus
- 4) Jesus appears on the road to Emmaus
- 5) Jesus is known in the breaking of bread
- 6) Jesus appears to the disciples in Jerusalem
- 7) Jesus gives the disciples his peace and the power to forgive sins
- 8) Jesus strengthens the faith of Thomas
- 9) Jesus appears by the Sea of Tiberias
- 10) Jesus forgives Peter and commands him to feed his sheep
- 11) Jesus commissions the disciples upon the mountain
- 12) The Ascension of Jesus
- 13) Mary and the disciples wait in prayer
- 14) The Holy Spirit descends at Pentecost
