Overview

Marksmanship, or "Riflery" as it is more commonly known, is an extremely popular GHSA sanctioned athletic competition held within JROTC programs around the United States. This program introduces cadets to marksmanship and the safe handling of an air rifle. Cadets will learn how to handle, clean, and fire the air rifle. Scholarships are also available at numerous colleges for marksmanship.

The JROTC Marksmanship Program is three position (standing, kneeling, & prone) marksmanship. This is a demanding sport that requires a maximum level of concentration and practice. The high school range is a standard 10 meters Civilian Marksmanship Program air rifle range for 8 competitors.

Most local competitions will include shooting from each position a total of 10 scored shots. National competitions may require 20 scored shots from each position.

Expectations for Cadets

Cadets selected to serve as a part of Cherokee High School's AF JROTC Marksmanship team will maintain high standards of conduct and a level of professionalism that is beyond reproach. They represent all others in their corps and their school.

Each cadet is expected to be constantly driven to excel by a deep devotion to duty and a strong sense of dedication.

Requirements

There is a maximum of 5 Cadets who can participate as part of the Varsity Marksmanship Team.

Attending and participating in practices is mandatory. Practices may be excused at the discretion of the coach.

Every member of the Marksmanship Team must be a cadet in good standing with Air Force JROTC and maintain passing grades in their academic classes.

Volunteer Opportunities for Parents

Parents will be called upon to provide transportation for cadets to and from community events.

Parents may also be asked to provide water and support during community events.

Team Practices/Preparation
