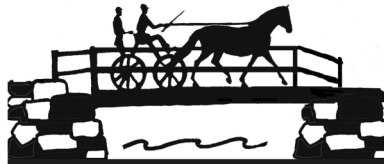

Chris Grieco, Manager of Fair Hill NRMA has kindly granted you provisional permission to use your ATVs to inspect obstacles/hazards. This is an exception to the rule and may be revoked at any time. Please set a good example, drive slowly and respect other park users who may be walking, biking, or riding. Please display your event supplied number and remember that helmets are mandatory at all times when driving ATVs. No two wheeled motorized vehicles are permitted!

This incredible park is a multiuse park. Please keep in mind that you may encounter riders out for pleasure whose horses may not be familiar with seeing a horse attached to a carriage! Please stop and make certain they are safe before you proceed. If you happen to be on course at the time, your calculated time can be adjusted at the end.

Cecil County Breeders Fair 4-H will share the stable area with us this weekend. Please consider that some of the 4-H horses in stabling may never have seen a carriage! Please .. Stop & let them look.

As with all events, Elk Creek requires tremendous financial and volunteer support. We are grateful to every contributor and every volunteer for their generosity! They make it possible for you the competitors and your equines to come to this beautiful park and play this game we love.... the sport of carriage driving.
