Out of Control Government Spending

Unlike the 1700s, we now have the technology to help us represent ourselves as individuals. As a nation, we have gone from **no taxation without representation**, to **high taxation with representation**. We can no longer trust our supposed representatives who sell out We the People. The time has come for **No Taxation Without SELF Representation**.

Article 1 Section 8 of the U.S. Constitution, renders the entire Constitution moot. The section states, "*The Congress shall have Power To lay and collect Taxes, Duties, Imposts and Excises, to pay the Debts and provide for the common Defence and general Welfare of the United States;*" The general welfare clause coupled with Congress' ability to raise debt and subsequently to lay taxes to pay off the debts, renders We the People defenseless against a tyrannical ruling class.

Given the current political environment, it would be impossible to get a Constitutional Amendment passed to fix this fatal flaw in the US Constitution. **But all we need is a simple majority in the House (218), Senate (51), and a willing President, to pass our bill.** Just like they pass any other bill, signed by the president.

We the People, will have to work together – nationally - to elect the right candidates, ***starting with yours truly***, who would be willing to hand over (won't be easy, but doable) the expenditure power to We the People. Under my proposed plan, the income tax rate will be flat at 10% for families making \$48K and up; zero for below. Congress will continue to pass spending bills as authorized in the Constitution. **However**, We the People will have the power to approve each spending item above 10% tax rate through our tax filings. This will be a radical departure from how the establishments control our money.

Highlights of the Proposal

No Taxation Without SELF Representation

Bill Passage

1. Any spending bill must be written by Congress on a stand-alone basis.
2. Bill cannot be more than 10 pages long in traditional format.
3. The title of the bill must match the content of the bill.
4. The vested parties, including lobbyists, elected representatives, and beneficiaries, must be clearly identified along with compensation (direct or indirect) they received from the vested parties.
5. Bill must cite Constitutional provision for passage.
6. No more than two spending bills can be passed on a Congress' "working" day. No more than 300 bills to be passed every year.
7. All expenditure bills must be passed by Congress/Senate by December 31st.

Role of IRS

8. IRS will be required to compile expenditure bills by January 31st of the following year in a chronological order. Process automation will save time/money/resources.
9. Taxpayers will then get to approve expenditures (see proposed tax form attached) with tax filing on April 15th.

Consent of the Governed

10. Taxpayers will be able to opt-in OR opt-out of each proposed expenditure. Please see proposed change to IRS Form 1040; line 15b is added.
11. Only those who opt-in will be required to pay taxes for the proposed expenditures.
No Taxation Without SELF-Representation.
12. A minimum threshold of willing "opt-in" taxpayers and total collectible taxes must be met for a given expenditure to pass.
13. Opt-ins must be done via online tax filing or paper filers should be subject to processing fee added to their personal taxes.
14. Opt-ins will be required to pay those proposed taxes at the time of filing. If the minimum thresholds are not met the money will be refunded back to them.
15. Bills must have a repeal/sunset provision of 180 days, June 30th.

Advantages for Taxpayers

16. This plan will force the federal gov. to prepare budgets in advance.
17. Many bloated federal bureaucracies will be eliminated.
18. Will **eliminate baseline budgeting**, as each department will have to live within the means of allocated budgets.

19. Will eliminate the need for short-term spending resolutions.
20. No last-minute “financial crisis” to hold the taxpayers hostage.
21. We the People can start the process of paying down the national debt.
22. Remove the dark money influence from [blackmailing](#) our representatives.

Tax Rate and Deductions

23. Personal income tax should be limited to **10% flat tax** with only mortgage deductions (including principal) allowed. This will encourage rapid personal savings.
24. From the 10% flat tax, federal government will have to fund the common defense/welfare such as US Armed Forces, DOT, power and communication grids, national parks, safety net and DOJ.

Poison Pill

25. To prevent this bill from ever being repealed, it must be mandatory that it can be repealed only if 75% of the citizens allow the repeal through a nationwide referendum.

Benefits to the Economy

26. There will be tremendous tax collection after lowering the tax rate, which can be in-turn used to pay down the debt.

Note: If a taxpayer selects “**Opt-out all**” on line 15b, his/her tax liability will be zero dollars to fund the proposed expenditure by Congress. If a taxpayer selects “**Opt-in all**”, he/she will be committing to maximum tax liability to fund the expenditures. A taxpayer who selects “**Selective Opt-in**” will be subject to taxes levied for spending they approve; in which case the tax amount will vary. This gives all taxpayers an equal chance to pay their fair share. For example, if a bill requires a funding of \$1 trillion and we have 100 million generous taxpayers, then share per taxpayer will be \$10,000.00 payable at the time of filing taxes on April 15, 20XX. Opt-outs will not be forced to pay this.

Taxpayers will have to submit Schedule U (see below), **only if** they select "Selective Opt-in" to approve a few expenditure items. Their American Fair Share Tax will vary.
