PREFACE

I would like to start with an excerpt from an antique book called **The Great Awakening in the Middle Colonies** by Charles Hartshorn Maxon which was published in 1920. The book highlights the founding of this great nation on Judeo-Christian principles and how different Christian denominations in the colonies came together during The Enlightenment Period to create a new American identity.

"The Great Awakening has sometimes been represented as a tempest of ungoverned passions that swept over the colonies, leaving wreckage everywhere in the alienations and divisions in families, neighborhoods, and churches, the undermining of cherished institutions, and a relapse into debauchery, and irreligion. An impartial study of the period, however, free from partisan and denominational bias, leads to a very different conclusion. It is that thousands and thousands were given by the Great Awakening a new view of **life's values**, and from this view were derived new energies and new sympathies which gave direction not only to the subsequent career of these thousands but to the development of the whole American people. It was more than wave on wave of excitement; it was a transforming process in the nation's life." (Chapter X, p. 139).



HINDU VALUES

Hinduism proudly stands on a foundation that does not have a drop of human blood mixed in natural propagation of our divine knowledge throughout the world over thousands of years. Our ancestors never forced our scriptural knowledge on anyone; they never used fear tactics on anyone to accept Hinduism or else be condemned to hell; they never used brutal force on non-believers, or raped their women, or killed their children, or plundered their material wealth to make them accept Hinduism.

Historically, Hinduism was not even labeled as a religion, rather it was deemed to be a simple way of life in His complex Creation. Anyone and everyone could/can practice a Hindu lifestyle. It is not the outer shell (clothes, accessories, food, language, etc.) of a human body that needs to change to be a Hindu, rather the invisible, eternal inner-self. Nowhere in our scriptures are we asked to gang up to force our will on others either by hook or by crook, or convert them to a singular way. In fact, we are asked to refrain from it because displaying arrogance of supremacy is deemed evil and demonic. Our scriptures are based on "self" and not the "collective."

We (humans) are mere landscapers to take care of His landscape until He asks us to retire. And while here on His created earth, He asked us through His scriptural knowledge to live a value-based life and follow practices to fulfill our social contract with other landscapers (including all life; plants, animals, birds, and aquatic creatures) whom He has sent to take care of His Creation.

Hindus believe in following basic human values to help sustain humanity and carve out a path for an individual's salvation.

- **★ Knowledge:** is the first step towards enlightenment.
- **★ Intellect:** intellectual honesty is key to absorbing knowledge.
- ★ **Humility:** humbleness, thankfulness, gratefulness in receiving God.
- ★ Purity: cleanliness of heart, mind, body, and the transcendental soul.
- ★ Natural Law: not deviating from the natural order birth to death.
- **★ Truth:** understanding and applying truth without prejudice.
- ★ Control of Senses: Control smell, taste, touch, sight, and hearing to live a balanced life. If not controlled; it can lead to greed, anger, and lust, and a total ruin of His beautiful Creation, including one's soul.
- **★ Non-Covetousness:** righteously build wealth, without coveting.
- **★ Patience:** Hindu belief is to build patience so that we are not impulsive in our actions.
- ★ Calm: impulsiveness can cause loss of control, thus ruin life.
- ★ Karma: accountability. Karma can be good or bad.
- ★ Service: provide service selflessly without a hidden agenda.
- **★ Forgiveness:** the ultimate virtue.

HINDU PRACTICES

A Hindu's life begins before birth and continues after death. The focus is not on the "body" but the invisible transcendental soul. While on earth, all Hindu values and practices are wrapped around slowing us down to build patience, perseverance, and purity to ultimately seek salvation.

In a Hindu's spiritual life, the values and practices are instilled from an early age. The main premise is to build character through:

- **★ Faith:** is a roadmap to seek salvation. It is a solo journey aided by parents, elders, and gurus. The journey is enlightened by worship.
- **★ Worship:** One God, a million Gods, or no God; Hindus worship to seek salvation through many ways prescribed in their scriptures.
- ★ Yoga: enlightenment yoga and work (service) yoga are different ways to serve Him. Here, yoga does not mean (physical) exercising yoga, but mental and spiritual practices.
- **★ Non-violence:** Harming His creation is violence (not to be confused with physical violence or crime). Violence (hurtful behavior) can be in speech and actions.
- **★ Patience:** Patience is an evolving virtue, perfected through practice. We must refrain from instant gratification; it can lead to dissatisfaction.
- ★ **Satisfaction:** Satisfaction is self-explanatory, but dissatisfaction happens when a person is detached from reality. It leads to anger, hatred, and loss of reason, which ruins a person's thinkability.
- ★ Honesty: in thoughts, words and conduct brings satisfaction in accepting the fruits for our labor as His blessings.
- **★ Compassion:** towards His Creation brings satisfaction and harmony.
- **★ Moderation:** balance in work and all aspects of life are necessary to live in peace and harmony.
- **★ Charity:** is unconditional giving to better His Creation.
- **★ Love:** unconditional love is free to give but priceless to receive.
- **★ Respect:** starts with first and foremost our parents, then gurus, righteous authority, fellow human beings and His entire Creation.
- **★ Sacred Vows:** can be spoken or even unspoken to respect His entire Creation.
- ★ Non-judgmental: Refrain from judging without knowledge and without reflection of values and practices.
- **★ Divine Conduct:** All of the above!

The noble words and actions in Values and Practices are in fact the classical liberal principles. The word "liberation" (of the soul) is key, but politics today make people shamelessly enslaved to coveting and dependent on inhumane satanic vices. Sadly, the corrupt governments make woke (immoral and unnatural) behavior legal and acceptable. Thus, forcing woke social experimenting on the masses to create conflict amongst We the People.

HINDU PERSECUTION

Hindus' rich heritage was under attack by foreign invaders long before B.C. More recently, the Hindu persecution started with the barbaric Islamic invasion around 1100 A.D., followed by the brutal colonial British rule from 1600 A.D. until 1947 A.D. After almost 1000 years of the dominance of foreign rule, Hindus emerged as a free and independent people in 1947 but were quickly engulfed by another foreign ideology called socialism.

Hindus' wealth was plundered, and the people tortured, women raped, and murdered for simply being "kafirs" or "pagans." Name calling and/or mocking have also been part of their evil strategy from the beginning. Evil wins because good retracts. Our good, peaceful ways were/are called pagan in nature, but looting, coveting, torturing, raping, forceful or deceitful conversions - now that's "civilized?" Most Hindus would prefer their paganism over being "civilized" and practicing greed, intolerance, conformity, a superiority complex, arrogance, brutality, judgmentalism, and hypocrisy.

In wars, Hindus were abiding by the rules of war by only engaging with the armies of warring factions, but the foreign invaders were barbaric in nature. Many of our original Hindu manuscripts, scriptures, and temples have been permanently destroyed by the Muslim and the British invaders.

After India's independence from colonial British in 1947, the socialists took over and continued the plunder of India and Hindus. Even the basic necessities in life, such as electricity and water, were denied by the socialist government, making the already Muslim-tortured, British-looted India, poorer, dirtier, unhygienic, meaner and lawless. The misery of foreign invasions and socialism brought India to extreme poverty in the modern world.

Under socialism, citizens struggle to make ends meet, and survival is only of the mightiest. No Missionaries

Hindu scriptural knowledge is always received, never solicited!

Have you ever noticed that there are no religious missionaries that knock on your door to promote Hinduism or ask you to convert to their peace-loving ideology for eternal salvation? It is not because we deem ourselves inferior or are ashamed of our religion, but because Hindu scriptures refrain followers from cheapening the value of their religion by promoting it unsolicited. Even in this pamphlet, I am not sharing my scriptural knowledge, but explaining why we Hindus do things the way we do.

Hindus do not impose their religious will on others or are judgmental of anyone's belief system. Hinduism is a decentralized, un-herded, eternal faith, and as Hindus, we follow our individual path for salvation with the help of a guru/teacher. The emphasis in our scriptures is on "personal responsibility" and clearly indicate that we must attain "self-realization" through "self-consciousness." Hinduism does not promote us vs. them ideology.

We are not encouraged to share our scriptural knowledge because God clearly mentions in our scriptures that finding Him is not an easy task. It takes education, wisdom, dedication, perseverance, and humility to receive His message. It is an individual's salvation and not "collective" salvation. Not using your own intellect to differentiate between right and wrong is inexcusable. Being herded to do wrong is also inexcusable.

Those who have criticized Hinduism until now were unopposed because there was never a counter defense presented. Going forward, please tell those vested interests not to act like cowards and criticize Hinduism without having a knowledgeable devout Hindu present there to counter their lies, or better yet, do your own research. The vested interests, herders, and the media (both on the right and the left) work towards keeping their followers in the dark.

Over time and over generations, the lies and the distortions take a strong hold in the minds of the followers, and they start believing in the superiority of their race, religion, and ideology. They get "mentally programmed" to either shut down any challenges to their belief system or they subconsciously trigger the Orwellian hate. Satan is the one who divides to conquer.

It may appear to those who have not read or understood Hinduism that there are a million Gods, but the reality is far different. His humility is breathtaking! He is the role model, the epitome of how He wants us to conduct ourselves in His image and be good stewards of His Creation. In all His reincarnations, He:

- ★ Honors His parents.
- ★ Honors His wife who is also revered as a Goddess.
- ★ Defends righteousness at all costs.
- ★ Does not harm His Creation for personal gain.
- ★ Does not promote vices such as lust, killing, cheating, coveting, raping, attacking the defenseless, even in His name. In fact, in Hindu scriptures, these acts are referred to as satanic in nature.
- ★ Never used lust as a reward to reach Heaven or Him.
- ★ Never preached killing fellow human beings to establish His Supremacy.

- ★ Delegated work to set an example for us, on how to get His job done, with humility without the arrogance of "I did it." He promotes teamwork. If He wants, He can do anything without seeking anyone's help, but He doesn't. He can also proclaim that He did it all by Himself. And yet, He doesn't.
- ★ Has created us in His Image and through His image he teaches us to live life like Him.
- ★ He is neither sexist nor treats women as inferior.
- ★ In many instances, He called out Goddess to destroy evil and show the world a woman's majestic power.
- ★ He set up different departments just like we would have in our lives. They are deemed as second tier Gods, who have their rules, regulations, and norms that Hindus need to follow to achieve material gains or conduct ourselves.
- ★ He wants men to live in His image and women in Her image.

Hindus have never fought to exert supremacy of any one of His manifestations over the other. Our scriptures show that He has found a way to reach every heart that has sought Him. Each one of us is different - (just look at our DNA) - with differing emotions, feelings, and faith that cannot be duplicated. Hinduism allows customizing love and devotion for Him.

It is like different people driving different cars (pick your options) to reach a destination (HIM), but everyone must follow the same set of traffic rules. Rule breakers are deemed satanic. Unlike cops who might occasionally catch the rule breakers, God is a cop who is always watching. Can't fool Him!

WOMEN'S RIGHTS

God is humble, He is not sexist, biased or considers anyone or anything in His Creation as inferior. It is us humans who have created these divisions and superiority complexes in a race, color, creed, religion, sex, or mindsets. Time and again, throughout Hindu history there are instances where women have taken the heroic lead to reestablish righteousness and destroy evil. Through various incarnations and manifestations, Goddesses (Women) have single-handedly, and independently of God (Man) displayed the strength of a woman with instances of great valor and courage.

BURNING WOMEN

leaders to commit atrocities against anyone, including women.



Hinduism has an extremely "**touchless**" culture and tradition, a quick example would be the Hindu way of greeting: **NAMASTE**, folding hands in respect to greet or welcome.

It is unconscionable for a devout Hindu woman to be **touched** by a man (except her father, brother, husband, and her male children). Their bodies are their sacred honor and

they have gone to great lengths to defend the sanctity of their being. Self-immolation was that ultimate sacrifice. But why self-immolate? This is what the western authors have intentionally not explained, of course, to further their motive and vested interest while demonizing Hinduism.

Please allow me to explain self-immolation. With the advent of the westerners invading India thousands of years ago, they brought "war practices" with them that were unfathomable to Hindus. Pre-western invasion wars between Hindu

kings and queens were fought between armies, and territories were won or lost. Women, children, civilians, and private properties were primarily left untouched. THEY CHOSE ASHES OVER DISHONOR. I request people to please stop mocking or disrespecting them for their purity, courage and sacrifice to defend their God-given sacred honor. This ritual is no longer practiced in India.

A side note on CREMATION: Hindus cremate dead bodies because of a simple spiritual concept. Earth is a bridge we cross and we should not occupy it with a permanent home for our dead body. We have to leave this earth for His new creations. We are born out of dust; thus, we should not leave anything behind but dust. The only thing we carry back to Him is our indestructible soul.

ARRANGED MARRIAGES

Hindu families are built like a Banyan tree. We don't like to bear fruits that fall away from the tree but grow roots that strengthen the main tree. Actually, this



is what has helped us survive the onslaught on our faith and traditions for thousands of years. We are a close-knit family.

The word "divorce" is absent from our root language Sanskrit. Many of us know genealogical dating back to thousands of years. In fact, in our prayers and rituals we invoke the name of the "main root" to pay our respects. Sadly, many of these roots were chipped away through forceful deceitful or conversions over the past few thousand years continue this day.

Hinduism has gone through turmoil after the westerners started invading India. The leftists and the socialists are further damaging Hindu traditions, just as they disrupt the natural order of our existence and nuclear family.

Hindus take the concept of a "nuclear family" to the highest level. Marriages are not deemed between two people, but two families to strengthen the roots of faith, culture and traditions. Generally, the parents of both the bride and the groom sit down and go through a host of issues to make sure that the young couple will be a good match for each other and family at large. The Hindu family structure involves generations living together, because there is a strong emphasis to honor not just the father and the mother, but the extended family as well.

Grandparents and other elders in the family are the caretakers when the young couple is building their life. Similarly, because parents take care of their offspring when they are unable to provide for themselves, the offspring take care of the parents when they are unable to take care of themselves during their old age. It is a great tradition of love, caring, and sacrifice that is passed on generation after generation. I would again refer to Hindu values and Hindu practices explained earlier to demonstrate how Hindu families have survived persecution.

Marriages are not deemed for sexual pleasure, but to carry out His will, and since most devout Hindu children grow up learning that, they are respectful of their traditions. They maintain celibacy until marriage. Meeting of two bodies as one soul, requires love, trust and selfless dedication and that is what is cultivated in Hindus from a young age.

For many devout Hindus, there is no reason for experimentation or reinventing the wheel in life, because the young couple has the guidance and nurturing of their elders, who may have faced similar situations in their marriage. And with continued parental guidance, divorce is not required, and families stay intact, without the need of recycling relationships. There is also no need for third party psychiatrists to counsel families, because there is always someone in the extended family who will connect with the troubled child/couple.

Dowry: There is no reference in Hindu scriptures to the practice of dowry. There is no equivalent word to the English word "dowry" in our root language Sanskrit. Traditionally, parents would voluntarily give their daughter gifts for her wedding, which they still do in all parts of the world. Hindu women were revered and maintained an equal or respectfully higher status in ancient India. With the brutal invasion of the west came their religious laws that also marginalized women's rights in India. Dowry was codified by the tyrannical British by passing laws giving men complete control over women and their property. Dowry was a European tradition brought to India by the British. One such reference is found in the marriage of British prince Charles II to Portuguese princess Catherine of Braganza in May of 1662. As part of her dowry, Bombay, which was part of the Portuguese-occupied territory was given to the British empire that occupied a large part of India.

The problem of dowry was exacerbated in socialist India after independence from colonial British in 1947. Brides got abused by the groom's family as an insurance policy to extort money to make ends meet. Socialism brings out the worst in mankind. With the basic necessities of life hard to achieve, people resorted to inhumane treatment of women. Dowry was decodified in India in 1961 by banning it. The practice has been eradicated to a great extent in modern India, where brides themselves are taking a strong stand against any demands of dowry. It is now a criminal offense to demand dowry.

Dowry will continue to be a blot on India, just as slavery, racism, and insurance killings continue to be a blot on the west.

LIVE FREE, LIVE FEARLESS AND TRANSCEND

FEARLESS: There is no fear instilled in Hindus to live a certain way or worship a certain way to seek salvation. We don't even have to believe in a God and we can still reach Him. There is no heaven and hell as a permanent place to be, but the ultimate goal for us is to seek salvation beyond those two destinations. As long as Hindus follow the Hindu Values & Practices, they are sure to reach Him. The mantra is *live fearlessly but righteously*! Righteous does not necessarily mean "religious."

BLASPHEMY: Hindus also do not have blasphemy laws. We are free to choose our path to Him. To seek salvation, Hindus abide by the basic human values of our social contract with fellow human beings and His entire Creation. We cannot wrap ourselves in ignorance, greed, lust, anger, arrogance and hypocrisy and expect a blissful result. We know through our subconsciousness and the Trinity situated within us that it is wrong to lie, cheat, kill, covet, bear false witness and be a hypocrite not just in His name, but even otherwise. These are considered demonic vices.

ACCOUNTABILITY: We as Hindus cannot knowingly choose the demonic path and expect Him to make up the difference when we die. To me, that's socialism: privatizing benefits of righteous behavior but socializing bad behavior - let someone else pick up the tab of bad karma. In Hinduism, there is accountability and personal responsibility at the core of "self-realization" through "self-consciousness." There is, of course, repentance, and salvation through penance for bad behavior - but again - that is through self-realization and self-consciousness.

WORSHIP FOR FREE: Hindu temples do not require memberships or forced contribution/donation to the priest or the temple. Therefore, they are not intrusive about our financial gains or incomes. Again, the importance is on the honor system and each one of us is supposed to contribute for the betterment of the faith based on a family's financial standing. All donations are voluntary, and the best form of charity is the one that no one knows, but Him. Unconditional service to family and community is a service to Him.

MIND YOUR OWN BUSINESS: The religious leaders of any Hindu temple have no reason to bad-mouth other religions to keep the congregation. In fact, there are no congregations because Hinduism is an unestablished, unherded, decentralized spiritual path. Hindu temples are open for anyone to walk in. Similarly, prayers are not a screaming contest but deemed best when no one hears them but Him. Hinduism focuses on the singularity of one's journey to Him without causing inconvenience to anyone or anything in His Creation.

THE IMPORTANCE OF A GURU

Time and again, His messages are also reinforced through gurus, pundits, teachers and priests. They all always have had the same message of peace and harmony. There are no contradictions, rewritings, or deviation from His righteous messages. That's why gurus are so revered in Hinduism. They are the teachers who help us see the Truth. Gurus are revered because they teach His teachings. The west, however, with control over the English language, has managed to associate a negative innuendo with the word "guru" – just like they have with many other Sanskrit words, such as "karma."

Thanks to guru-disciple and traditional close-knit Hindu family structures, the scriptural knowledge and the history have been very well preserved. Well-preserved even after the tyrannical Muslim and British rulers' repeated attempts to destroy the temples, Hindu institutes of learning, and the manuscripts. There are no old and new versions of His Reincarnations or revisions of Hindu scriptures to fit the political correctness of the day and age.

However, many gurus today (just like religious leaders from other religions) lean left politically, primarily to save their skin against media onslaught and character assassinations. They like the TV time and likes they receive to propagate leftist causes, while hiding behind the noble, gentle and kind messaging of our faith. They promote socialist messages without ever talking about the disastrous effects of socialism on mankind.

And that's why I am fighting this fight. Let's rebuild the world around us based on moral values, nuclear family values and country values that are common for all of us, regardless of race, color, creed, or religion. I see an alliance of peace and prosperity loving, We the People, as the only way to preserve God's permanent treasure through our temporary presence on earth!

A guru is one who will not force his personal belief on his/her disciples but guides them to find Him. A guru makes a person humble, fearless about knowing Him and not fearful of not accepting Him. A guru teaches how to look for source material and not believe hearsays. A guru teaches how to respectfully discern and question authority. A guru does not start a sect or a cult or a following or a denomination for himself but leads us to find Him. A guru is not driven by greed but extends his knowledge to his disciples.

A guru does not perform miracles. Only a con-man does and then calls himself a godman. There have been fake gurus and teachers who have tried to start a sect or a following by promoting a new denomination. Hindus can smartly figure that out and reject it. Hinduism does not require fear, deceit, mandatory contribution to any cause; hypocrisy of words v. actions; living with a superiority complex, and violence. When Hindus see such messages or demeanor, they are quick to walk away from it.

THE MULTITUDINOUSLY AND COMPLEXLY COMPLETE FAITH

Hinduism is a complex and complete faith because it deals in the entirety of an individual (mind, body and soul) with the Absolute. What seems complex to an outsider is a simple way of life for a practicing Hindu. Only a practicing Hindu's brain or a devout western researcher is capable of comprehending and bringing into practice what Hinduism offers for our temporary life on earth. Hinduism offers the cause, effect and remedy to complex life situations. Each aspect of our life is interconnected and interdependent with nature and must be balanced to live a complete life.

Of the many Hindu teachings, some that many can relate to are:

- ★ Yoga: for mind, body and soul. After early hesitance, the west has now adopted the Hindu practice of yoga, because the benefits are undeniably substantiated by medical science.
- ★ Herbal Medicine: The West is starting to understand the benefits of the Hindu diet, and use of herbs and spices in our daily life. Also, the benefits of fruits, vegetables and grains explained in ancient Hindu scriptures are now making headways into the modern medical sciences.
- ★ **Astronomy:** Hindu scriptures have explained the planets around us and their effect on earth and its habitants. The Hindu lunar calendar dates back to the beginning of time that explains the movements of planets in the solar system and their effect on our mind, body, and soul. The remedies are provided to keep our lives in balance with the planetary movements.
- ★ Architecture: and the Science of Construction: Chinese Feng-shui is now being used in many homes in the west. The Indian science of construction aligns not only the aspects of all natural elements surrounding us, but also the planetary movements of earth in correlation with other planets.
- ★ **Astrology**: The west is finally realizing the effect of the moon phases on the human mind, which our scriptures have explained thousands of years ago. Hinduism provides an extremely advanced science that explains the effects of all planets on our daily lives, from birth to death. This science is also a very good predictor of the past, present, and the future ups and downs in a person's life due to the movement of planets in the solar system.
- ★ Weaponry: In our modern-day science we have voice-activated arsenals, which is described in great detail in scriptures from thousands of years ago. What we refer to as a "voice-activated" command is known as a "mantra" in Hindu scriptures.

It is almost impossible for an individual to comprehend all these sciences in one lifetime, and therefore, we go to gurus in each field for advice, as and when needed. They are all interconnected and as Hindus we can easily connect the dots of our multi-dimensional complex life.

HOLY COW

What's the beef between Hindus and cows?

Hindu scriptures call for *non-violence* against every life in His entire Creation. Our scriptures specifically mention **not to kill**, and that includes any moving life. Hinduism does not provide lip service or selective killing to the principle of non-violence. Only the Warrior Class (explained later in this pamphlet) was allowed to kill and consume animals, if necessary.

Hindu scriptures do not mention a food chain with humans on top, but do mention a balanced diet of herbs, grains, vegetables, and fruits. Even modern-day health science now calls for the balanced diet that Hinduism has been preaching since thousands of years. **To Him, all lives matter**, because He created every life. It is the human mind that created the food chain to fit our human lifestyle.

He is G-O-D and He has knowingly created safeguards to protect all life. Through His many reincarnations and manifestations, He has "adopted" animals as His pets. This was His way of promoting kindness among human beings towards His creation. He did not adopt every single animal, bird or aquatic creature on earth, but the cow in particular has been a revered animal in Hindu scriptures. The cow is held to a higher ethical standard, because cow has been an integral part of Hindu heritage and traditional beliefs.

In one of His reincarnations, He was separated at birth from His biological mother. It was the cow's milk that was the best substitute for His mother's milk. To Him, the cow gave Him what a mother gives selflessly to her child. A cow embodies the Hindu virtues of tolerance, non-violence, dignity, humbleness, and strength. A cow is a kind animal, a selfless being, and owning a cow(s) was considered a symbol of prosperity and abundance.

Cows and her family are domestic animals and have had a long cultural and historical significance as they have been an integral part of Hindu lives. This relationship is what makes Hindus so passionate about not eating beef. In the west, some farmers don't slaughter and eat animals (even cows) they raise on their farms due to the relationship they build with the animal. A law was passed in the U.S. in 2018 to stop the slaughter and consumption of domestic animals such as dogs and cats. Horse meat is also not available for consumption in the US. Pork is forbidden for consumption amongst Muslims and in countries with Sharia Law.

Hindus are also not militantly vegan trying to force veganism on the world; they just go about their ways, and follow their faith. So why mock Hindus for being kind, gentle, loving and affectionate towards not only the cows, but to all life in His Creation? Is it because there is no fear of Hindus beheading anyone for insulting or demeaning their faith?

THE CASTE SYSTEM

The "caste system" (social status) exists in every race, color, creed and religion. The correct explanation to the caste system is "occupational categories" that have existed throughout human history and will continue to the end of time. The British exploited Hindus by pitching them against each other by injecting "social status" on one group against another. Our scriptures talk about pure capitalism and how each of the occupational categories can progress.

Universally, there are only four occupational categories, we cannot create a fifth or more:

Brahmins: **The Intellectual Class**: People who work with their minds to be gainfully employed fall in this category. Some of the examples would be teachers, doctors, lawyers, government officials, researchers, and priests. The income of these individuals is irrelevant, but they do get more respect due to their higher hierarchical position in society. They (sometimes) also have access to better things in life because of their social status. Isn't this true in every part of the world even today?

Vaishyas: **The Business Class**: Those who manufacture goods or produce agricultural products, buy and sell goods fall in this category. They are the capitalists. Capitalism in itself is not immoral, but crony capitalism is. Crony capitalism is making money with unfair tactics or illicit advantage. Our scriptures denounce greed and there are consequences to bad karma of making money immorally. However, there was no limit to how much a person could make through righteous means. Again, doesn't the business class exist in every society? Can't they afford better things in life if they are successful?

Kshatriya: **The Warrior Class**: The name explains it all. These were the defenders of a community, and the kingdom they served. They were mostly gainfully employed by the kingdom they served. This warrior class was given leeway in the Hindu principle of non-violence, and that too for a specific reason. They had to get immune to seeing blood pouring out of a body and the pain associated with it. They were allowed to kill wild animals for practicing their warrior skills. Domestic animals (especially cows) were not part of their practice schedules. They were allowed to consume meat, because wars could have kept them away from their homes. Please remember, in ancient days, it was mainly hand to hand combat, and the fight could have been between two unknown soldiers, and it had to be merciless. Any emotional weakness could have led to a loss in war.

Shudra: **The Labor Class**: The labor class consisted of those who worked with their hands. A shudra (labor class skilled artisan) could move up in the occupational category (caste system) by setting up a shop and becoming a trader (business class category) of his skill by creating products that people wanted and needed.

In each of the categories, one had to be proficient in the trade and practice. Individuals were free to move from one category to the other. For example, someone from the labor class could move into a business class by setting up a shop. My own family went on from a priest (Brahmin) class to a farming (Business) class, but they maintained their roots of daily prayers and rituals even after moving into the business category. There were never any restrictions on how an individual or a family sought Him. Hindus have always been free to find Him in their own unique ways as were prescribed in various scriptures.

Most importantly, if the community or the nation was attacked by a foreign entity, it was the duty of every citizen to take up arms (become Warrior class) to defend their boundaries. After the war was over and threat negated, people would go back to their professions.

BIRDS OF THE SAME FEATHER

From what is evident from the historical perspective on Hinduism, there were no hard and fast rules for an individual to be stuck in one professional category (caste) or the other. There were also no mandatory requirements that an individual stays in the profession (caste) his/her family belonged to. But the families preferred to marry or associate with other families from the same professional category (caste). The main reason was the cultural fit between the two families. There would have been less friction or needed adjustment for people from the same profession (caste) to mingle with each other. The caste system (if we can really call it that) became more rigid and continued to take a hardline approach after the west started attacking Hindus, both verbally and physically. Hindus had to move to the safe quarters of their closest community to safeguard their culture and traditions from the tyrannical persecution at the hands of British and Muslim invaders.

It is a natural human phenomenon, to move closer to their comfort and/or safety zone. Take my election for an example, given the everyday attacks on my faith, it is quite understandable that many Christians and Americans were apprehensive about voting for me because they were more comfortable with their kind of candidate. I don't have any qualms about it, and understand that most people would do what they did and for the reasons they did. It is rare that a guy like me comes along who is willing to get out of the comfort zone and walk towards the fire. Please pardon me for making you uncomfortable.

These professional categories exist in every race, color, creed and religion but, Hindu faith is the only faith that describes in extensive detail every aspect of our life. Duties and responsibilities of each professional category are very well defined, and expectations are realistic so that people would know how to seek job satisfaction. Hinduism does not promote material expectation, but instead promotes accepting the fruits of labor as His blessings. Most Hindus were realistic in their approach about life and could strive to be better. Using the emotional wedge of "dissatisfaction" the tyrannical British colonizers

fabricated a "divide and rule" strategy to pitch Hindus against each other in the name of "justice." They created non-existent "inequalities" in a culture that was based on Hindu values of satisfaction, humility, thankfulness, and gratefulness.

Americans can relate to this "divide and conquer" strategy in the form of the socialist/communist and similar divisive movements taking hold in America. It is very easy to make anyone emotionally unstable by injecting dissatisfaction and jealousies. A simple statement disguised as sympathy can easily do the damage, for example, "you work so hard, but you don't get just compensation for that." Such a statement will win the heart and easily stir up the emotions. The flip side would be to try and win the head by saying, "you should see how your manager got where he is and learn from him to emulate his success." This statement seems callous because it requires hard work. Most people will prefer to be spoken to with sympathy (even if with a hidden evil agenda) and play into the hands of the "sympathizer".

UNTOUCHABILITY

Untouchability has never been part of the Hindu religious texts, but became a blot on Hinduism, just like slavery has been a blot on the social fabric of the western world. The concept of untouchability stemmed out of the uncleanliness of body of certain people. Later even the British were considered untouchables because they were deemed unclean, cruel and deceptive in their practices, same as Muslims.

To understand untouchability of a caste (occupation), one needs to travel back in time. Antique India's hygiene practices were far better than the COVID era. The untouchables were sadly the lowest in the hierarchy of occupations. They were people of a community engaged in collecting human excrement, these were the "soil men and women" of the forgotten era.

Please understand while reading this that plumbed toilets were invented just



a few centuries ago, and most societies/countries used someone to transport or deal with the human waste.

The sad part was that because they were deemed physically dirty, for their line of work, they were not allowed in people's homes, communities and temples. They were almost living a condemned life and lived segregated. Their children were not integrated into society and were not accepted in schools.

They had separate entrances and exits and were not allowed to come close to people of other castes. The untouchables were also not allowed to draw <u>water</u>

from the same well that other castes could draw from. They were not <u>served</u> by other castes and regularly discriminated against for who they were.

As sad as I am to report that while untouchability was part of India, I am also proud to say that Hindus, as a race or


people of brown shades,
