GENERAL INFORMATION

MSO is a selected blend of modified vegetable oils and nonionic surfactants. Its use will improve the performance of spray applications by enhancing the penetration of active ingredients through the weather hardened cuticle of targeted pests to the mode of action site. **MSO** slows drying time which enables better uptake of the pesticide and more complete pest control. **MSO**'s select components afford enhanced infiltration of pest control agents that require or recommend the use of an MSO, ESO or MVO.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Follow the directions on all pesticide labels. Use **MSO** with any pesticide that requires or suggests the use of an MSO, ESO, MVO or other oil-based adjuvant. The first time the product is used, perform a compatibility (jar) and phytotoxicity test before application. Care should be used on sensitive species as the product could increase sensitivity to light. If the label allows the use of an MSO but does not recommend a rate, add 1-1/2 to 2 pints per acre of **MSO** to the spray tank. Extra product may be needed on weeds with heavier wax, or under dry or dusty conditions or for more mature weeds. Not for aquatic use.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions on the pest control product manufacturer's label. If instructions are not provided, follow these general guidelines: 1) Fill spray tank 2/3 to 3/4 full of water. 2) Add dry flowables (DF) and wettable powders (WP). 3) Agitate until thoroughly dispersed. 4) Continue the addition of other active ingredients, then adjuvants including **MSO**, according to the directions on the pesticide label. *Note:* Tank mixtures including **MSO** should be utilized within 36 hours for best results.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Causes eye irritation. Read label before use. Keep container tightly closed. Keep only in original container. Avoid breathing vapors or spray. Wash thoroughly after handling. Do not eat, drink or smoke when using this product.

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT: Wear protective gloves, protective clothing, eye protection and face protection.

FIRST AID

IF SWALLOWED: Call a doctor or poison control center if you feel unwell. Rinse mouth. Do not induce vomiting unless told to by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. If irritation persists, call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN: Take off contaminated clothing and wash it before reuse. Wash skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 - 20 minutes. If irritation occurs, call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing call 911, then give artificial respiration. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place. Store in original container only. Do not add anything to the container. Keep container tightly sealed when not in use. Do not store near fire, flame or other potential sources of ignition. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal of this product. For optimal storage, store between 40° and 90° F.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Triple rinse (or equivalent) during mixing and loading. Recycling decontaminated containers is the best option of container disposal if allowed by law. The Agricultural Container Recycling Council (ACRC) operates the national recycling program. To contact your state and local ACRC recycler visit the ACRC web page at www.acrecycle.org. Decontaminated containers and materials must be disposed of in a manner allowed by local, state and federal laws and regulations.
