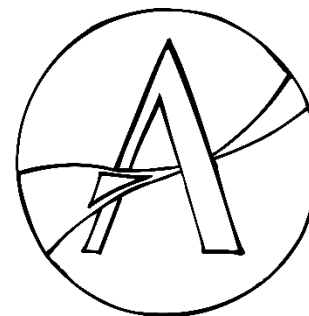

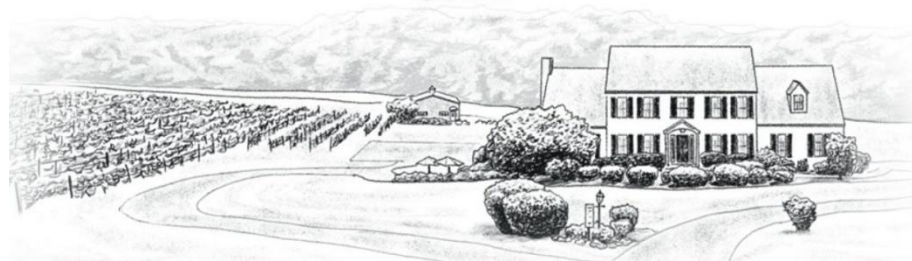

Full bodied Chambourcin with red vinifera blending fraction. Aged in French barriques. Dark berries, leather, and peppery spice aromas. Dry.

Tidal

Cherry, pomegranate, strawberry preserves. Chambourcin, blended with Merlot, Cabernet Franc, and Petit Verdot. Round and fruit forward. Off-dry.
