Payment: Payment is due in full prior to the commencement of lessons. If you have any questions regarding payment, please contact the studio before enrolling. Artwork will not be released until fees are paid in full or otherwise arranged.

Studio Conduct Arrival: All studio members are to arrive five minutes before class. If you arrive earlier and the studio is not open, please wait in the foyer area until the studio is opened.

Check-in/Check-out: When dropping off and picking up your children, please check in with a staff member before leaving. All children are to be accompanied by a parent or guardian when dropping off and picking up, unless otherwise arranged with staff. Parents and guardians are to remain in easy contact with the studio in the event of an emergency.

Attire: All art studio members are to wear old clothing or a paint shirt (plastic art smocks are not always recommended) and semi-covered or covered footwear in the studio. (No school uniforms, please.)

Food and Beverages: No food, toys, etc. are to be brought into the studio. Drinking water is always provided.

Bathroom Breaks: Please ensure that your child has gone to the toilet before the lesson so that there is no disruption to class time.

Pace of Work: All art studio members work at their own pace. Generally, most tasks will take one to two lessons to complete. Occasionally, more involved work will take a little longer.

Absences: As a member of Da Vinci Art Studio, you are required to notify the studio if you are unwell or unable to attend a lesson by sending a text message or email.

Missed Classes: If you have missed a class due to ill health, other commitments etc., you can arrange to attend another class in the same week depending on availability. Due to the nature of the art course, we may not be able to repeat a lesson if the lesson has progressed. You are welcome to ask for materials and continue the lesson at home in your own time.

Refunds: You are not eligible for a refund for lessons missed during term. Due to the nature of our classes, we cannot arrange make-up classes. If you are absent from your normal class, you may contact the studio to ask if it is possible to attend on another day within the same week, depending on availability. The term fee is set under the principle that you have booked your place in that class for the term. If you cannot attend for an extended period, we are unfortunately unable to refund your fees as they are a set cost of membership for the term.

Our Tutors: All classes are guided by qualified art tutors and practicing career artists. All staff have undergone working with childrens checks and criminal checks.

Dedication: We are a dedicated team of artists with the intention of giving our students the guidance needed to develop a thorough skill set for fine art application.

Hygiene Procedures: Please sanitize your hands upon entering and exiting the studio. If you or anyone in your family is unwell, please do not attend the studio and contact the studio to inform us. To keep everyone safe, please maintain open communication with the studio.
