► TRAINING SPOTLIGHT

Body blocking is the art of using our bodies to move dogs away from our space. Using our bodies in a non-threatening, neutral manner sends a signal to the dogs that we are in charge of the room and have the ability to claim neutral territory from them. In a daycare environment, you will notice body blocking amongst the dogs as well. Two dogs that might be staring at each other will have a third dog interrupt by walking in-between them a form of body blocking. We will use body blocking for the wait at the gate activity, the stay out of my space activity, and a variety of other scenarios in daycare. You may have noticed the yellow and pink circles around the buildings.

► DID YOU KNOW....

A common question our clients ask is "Why is my dog so thirsty when he comes home?" Every dog at OKCC has access to water at all times, both during the day and while spending the night for a kennel boarding sleepover. If your dog is active in daycare, playing can be a very physical activity. Just like people, the more active dogs are, the more water they will need to drink. Also, the excitement of being home might make your dog happy, bouncy and overstimulated, which can cause them to be extra thirsty. Be assured, that your dog is always getting plenty of water during their visit with us.
