We are seeking a qualified candidate for the position of a General Service Technician I with skills and experience to contribute to the Solid Waste Department. This individual will perform all aspects of daily operations of the Solid Waste Transfer Station. He/she will need to adapt to various situations, communicate well, and exercise independent sound judgement to assigned responsibilities.

Major duties and Responsibilities (may include, but not limited to the following)

- Ensure grounds and driveways are maintained in an orderly, hazard free manner by appropriately cleaning debris as necessary.
- Maintain recycling area by separating and organizing recyclable materials.
- Separate and dispose white goods i.e. washers, dryers, refrigerators and TVs based on size and specific groups.
- Assist in the operation and maintenance of heavy equipment such as backhoes, refuse trucks, and septic tank pumper trucks.
- Assists with the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program
- Performs routine reporting, record keeping and mathematical calculations, and communicates with management, co-workers, and the public.
