We are seeking an individual who is self-motived, adaptable and a great problem solver to join the Operators Team. This individual will provide assistances to install or replace water, sewer, septic and drain filed infrastructure according to I.H.S. specifications and regulations.

Major duties and Responsibilities (may include, but not limited to the following)

- Utilize blueprints and design to cost effectively install systems.
- Connect water service to existing infrastructure.
- Install individual wells and pumping systems
- Cisterns with pumping system installation
- Sewer service connections to existing infrastructure systems, including gravity laterals, individual lift stations and sewer force mains: grinder pumps and sewer force mains
- Convention septic systems installation (Septic tank with chamber drain field or In-drain mat system)
- Septic tank and effluent pump and mound or peat biofilter system installations
- Evapotranspiration septic system (ET) installation
- Trenching utilizing heavy equipment or hand tools
- Laser and leveling ground according to grade requirement
- Assist in operation and maintenance of heavy equipment such as backhoes, front loaders and trucks

Qualifications

High school diploma or GED. Basic knowledge of water and sewer treatment methods, process control techniques, and equipment O & M. Basic knowledge of writing, math, computer and plumbing skills required. Must be available to respond to emergency situations as needed. Must have a valid New Mexico Driver's License with no serious convictions in the past five years and must be insurable under POLUA's carrier.
