We are seeking a qualified candidate for the position of a Meter Technician with skills, experience to contribute to the Operations Department. This individual will perform all aspects of daily operations and preventative maintenance to the Pueblo's drinking water system. He/she will need to adapt to various situations, communicate well, and exercise independent sound and judgement to responsibilities.

Major duties and Responsibilities (may include, but not limited to the following)

- Reads, operates, maintains, and repairs water meters.
- Tests and calibrates water meters to departmental standards.
- Keeps a record of new water meter installations, exchanges and repairs.
- Installs, replaces, repairs, inspects and maintains residential and commercial water meters and hydrant meters used by construction contractors.
- Assists in the installation, repair and maintenance of Pueblo's water system including water mains, water service lines and fire hydrants.
- Responds to emergency calls as needed; is expected to work odd hours and on holidays as the job duties require.

Qualifications: High school diploma or GED and one-year experience in water or wastewater operations. Knowledge of water meters, their operation, maintenance and equipment O & M. Basic knowledge of writing, math, computer and mechanical skills required. Must be available to respond to emergency situations as needed. Current valid New Mexico Driver's License with no major infractions (such as DUI) within the past 5 years and insurable under POLUA's insurance carrier. Must be able to successfully pass a pre-employment drug/alcohol screen and background investigation.
