We are seeking a qualified candidate for the position of Field Service Technician with skills and experience to contribute to the Solid Waste Department. This individual will perform all aspects of the daily operations of the Solid Waste Transfer Station. They will need to adapt to various situations, effective communication skills well, and exercise sound judgement to assigned responsibilities.

Major duties and Responsibilities (may include, but not limited to the following)

- Maintains grounds and driveways are in an orderly, hazard free manner by appropriately cleaning debris, as necessary.
- Maintain recycling area by separating and organizing recyclable materials.
- Separate and disposal of white goods i.e., washers, dryers, refrigerators, and TVs based on size and specific groups.
- Assist in the operation and maintenance of heavy equipment such as backhoes, refuse trucks, and septic tank pumper trucks.
- Assists with the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) when assistance is available.
- Performs routine reporting, record keeping and mathematical calculations, and effectively communicates with management, co-workers, and the public.

Qualifications:

- High school diploma or GED and one-year experience in groundskeeping field. Knowledge of large and small equipment and their operation and maintenance.
- Knowledge of materials, methods, practices, and equipment used for maintenance and operations of solid waste transfer station.
