

## Important Information about Your Drinking Water

## Availability of Monitoring Data for Unregulated Contaminants for the Laguna Valley Water System 063503111

As required by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), our water system has sampled for a series of unregulated contaminants under the EPA's Unregulated Contaminant Monitoring Rule (UCMR). Unregulated contaminants are those that do not yet have a drinking water standard set by EPA. The purpose of monitoring for these contaminants is to help EPA decide whether the contaminants should have a public health protection standard.

## What should I do?

You do not have to do anything but as our customers you have a right to know that these data are available.

You may share this information with other people who drink this water, especially those who may not have received this notice directly (for example, people in apartments, nursing homes, schools, food establishments, medical facilities, and businesses).

The analyte lithium was sampled in February and August 2023 where the results ranged from 36.1 to 343  $\mu$ g/L with an average lithium result of 233.7  $\mu$ g/L.
