What is LIHWAP?

The Low Income Household Water Assistance Program (LIHWAP) is a temporary program to help low-income families pay overdue water, sewer, and/or septic bills. LIHWAP is a grant. You do not have to repay it.

LIHWAP Can:

- Pay current and past due water, sewer & septic bills
- Pay fees and interest assessed on your account
- Help you reestablish terminated water, sewer & septic services

How do I apply?

- Request an application by calling the PoLUA at (505) 552-9631
- Applications are available at the PoLUA administrative offices located at 6 Arrowhead Rd, Laguna, NM
- Visit our website at www.lagunaua.org to download an application

To apply, you will need:

- Names of people in your household;
- Dates of birth for all household members;
- Social Security numbers for all household members;
- Proof of income for all household members; and
- A recent water bill.

Who is Eligible?

- Must be under income maximum*
- Must demonstrate a water burden
- Must demonstrate Laguna Tribal member status
