

- exceed 45 consecutive days and removed for a period 45 consecutive days.
6. Temporary Sign/Banner permits in Unincorporated Shelby County shall be for a period not to exceed 45 consecutive days and for a cumulative period not to exceed 180 days in a calendar year.
 7. Immediately upon expiration of the permit the temporary sign/banner shall be removed.

The following support documentation and fees must be submitted with completed & signed application

1. Drawing of the sign shown on the building or leased space or site plan showing the location of the sign on the property with setbacks from property lines.
2. Drawing of the sign with dimensions shown.
3. If the property is located in the Shelbyville Historic District, an approved Certificate of Appropriateness (COA) from the Historic District Commission (502-844-2277) is required.
4. Application fee, non-refundable, payable to Triple S Planning Commission.
