

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING

SINGLE ENTRIES

Bird Dog Classes - Class for dogs & class for bitches that have earned Working Dog (WD) or Working Dog Excellent (WDX) titles from the Parent Club or have received a qualifying score at any AKC Hunting Test or have received a placement at an AKC Field Trial. Classes to be held after Winners Bitch and before Best of Breed. Winners of the Bird Dog Class are eligible to compete for BOB.

Veteran Classes. Classes for dogs & bitches 7 years & under 9 years; 9 years & under 11 years; 11 years and over. Sexes divided. Veteran Dogs & Bitches are eligible for Best of Breed/Variety competition and thus must be intact.

- Bred-by-Exhibitor (BBE) Class Eligibility

 All dogs entered in the Bred by Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC.
- The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog.

 • To exhibit in this class, family members must be a
- breeder and owner of record.

Amateur-Owner-Handler - For dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog and is limited to exhibitors who have not, any any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler.

MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES

The Miscellaneous Classes for each breed shall be divided Puppy and Open. These classes shall be divided by sex. All class winners within a breed shall compete for Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed. Each of the Miscellaneous Class Best of Breed Winners shall be eligible to compete for Best in Miscellaneous Class. There shall be no further competition for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Classes.

JUDGES
