All City and State Regulations in effect during these events will be enforced.

While COVID restrictions have been lifted at this time, circumstances may change as the CDC communicates their recommendations. The potential for a change and anyone that has already entered, judges, and vendors, this is the notice to any change of restrictions will apply at the time of the event. Judges are to adhere to the applicable state, local, facility and club guidelines in place at the time the event is held. However, we strongly suggest that if your judge is wearing a mask in the ring, that all entering the ring should also.

Prime Parking/Grooming (Complete form, limited availability)

- Prime parking/Groom allows for closer proximity to the rings while grooming at your vehicle.

Overnight Parking (Complete form, limited availability)

- R V, Motorhomes and oversized vehicles not reserving space arriving on the day of show may have limited space or availability.

Cooperation with the Club officials, committees, members, site control & parking personnel, including following all instructions and directions, is mandatory and required. The use of rude, abusive or foul language, arguing and/or not complying and any objectionable behavior against anyone will be immediately subject to a Bench Show Hearing. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS.

RAMP INFO

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp through all levels of competition: AMERICAN WATER SPANIEL, BOYKIN SPANIEL, ENGLISH SPRINGER SPANIEL, FIELD SPANIEL, LAGOTTO ROMAGNOLO, NS DUCK TOLLING RETRIEVER, WELSH SPRINGER SPANIEL, GRAND BASSET GRIFFON VENDEEN, WHIPPET (Ground/Table), GERMAN PINSCHER (Eff. 8/8/22), STANDARD SCHNAUZERS, AMERICAN STAFFORDSHIRE, IRISH TERRIERS, KERRY BLUE TERRIER, MINI BULL TERRIER (Ground/Table), SOFT COATED WHEATEN TERRIER, STAFFORDSHIRE BULL TERRIER, FINNISH SPITZ, ENTLEBUCHER MOUNTAIN DOG, FINNISH LAPPHUND, ICELANDIC SHEEPDOGS, MUDI (or Table), NORWEGIAN BUHUND, POLISH LOWLAND SHEEPDOG, SPANISH WATER DOG, NORRBOTTENSPETS (Misc.)

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: CLUMBER SPANIEL, SUSSEX SPANIEL, BASSET HOUND, CIRNECO DELL'ETNA, BULLDOG, CHINESE SHAR-PEI, CHOW CHOWS, KEESHONDEN

This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions. Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed.

In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breed.

A founder of the Canine Conservation movement, Mr. Johnson, strives to be a voice for all breeders who work tirelessly to produce and promote their breed of choice. Advocating for dogs is a passion, but also a responsibility to ensure the successful longevity of unique breeds. Together we must continue to foster the best breeding practices to keep breeds from extinction.

The gift of a Clumber Spaniel for his birthday from his parents started Douglas Johnson down the path of lifetime dedication to the sport of purebred dogs.

Breeding under the world-famous Clussexx prefix, he has produced more than 200 Champion Clumber Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Welsh Springer Spaniels, and English Toy Spaniels. Clussexx dogs have won more than 150 Best in Show awards and 15 national specialties wins across four breeds.

Mr. Johnson holds the distinct honor of producing two Westminster Best in Show winners, and he is the only breeder of Westminster Best in Show winners in two different breeds. The winners are Clumber Spaniel Ch. Clussexx Country Sunrise "Brady" in 1996 and Sussex Spaniel Ch. Clussexx Three D Grinchy Glee "Stump," Stump in 2006. Stump, a veteran at 10 years, is the oldest dog to ever win Best in Show at Westminster.

Mr. Johnson was awarded American Kennel Club's Sporting Breeder of the Year award in 2005, Judge of the Year Nominee for 2017, and a Winkie Award Winner for Breeder of the Year in 2019. He is a member of the Santa Barbara Kennel Club, Hoosier Kennel Club, The Bloomington Indiana Kennel Club, and a lifetime member of the Clumber Spaniel Club of America.

**BEST OWNER-HANDLED IN SHOW COMPETITION
Big Apple Sporting Society
Big Apple Working Dog Club
September 30, 2022 - National Owner-Handled Series
(Remember to check the box near the bottom of the entry form)**

The AKC Owner/Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners who are not professional handlers. This series of special competitions will be offered at dog shows across the country.

All dogs that are owner/handled and are not owned or exhibited by professional handlers' meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner/Handler eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book and the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the competition by an eligible owner. Professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in this competition.

The Owner Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner Handled Best of Breed/Variety and be eligible to compete in both the regular as well as the Owner-Handled Group.
- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition ineligible and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety will compete against the eligible undefeated exhibits of the owner sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If the Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety are both ineligible and Select Dog and Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all dogs of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
- If Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch are ineligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog remaining in the ring including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.

The breed will not be represented in the Owner-Handled Group if there is no eligible dog competing in the Best of Breed or in Best of Winners Competition.

*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay or received payment for handling a dog.

Entry blank MUST be filled out with the necessary information, otherwise the entry in Junior Showmanship will not be accepted.

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS: This Class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to entry the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

Competition must exist for Best Junior Handler.

If a dog is entered in more than one class in one of these events, the AKC Recording Fee and Service Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. CANADIAN EXHIBITORS make fees payable in **U.S. FUNDS. CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST USE INDIVIDUAL REGISTRATION NUMBERS - LITTER NUMBERS NOT ACCEPTED.**

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

POST DATED CHECKS, RETURNED CHECKS AND DECLINED CREDIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry. The Superintendent will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check or declined card. Subsequent returned checks or declined credit cards from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a **CASH ONLY BASIS.**

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if a dog has been processed, no refund will be made.

CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIME OF JUDGING.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **DOGS NOT REQUIRED** for further judging will be excused.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show-giving club and the superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising pen.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Superintendent to be advised at once. The Superintendent and Show-giving Club may disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

Effective January 1, 2009 - Refund and Cash award checks are void after 180 days and will NOT be re-issued.

An administrative fee of \$2.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
