GREETERS

Thank you for agreeing to be a poll greeter! Here are some do's and don'ts for this role, and contact information if you have any questions during your shift(s).

- 1. Your role is to let every voter know how much their ballot is appreciated in this Special Election, *and also know that we'll be needing their support again in 2026*. Thank every voter on the way in, and again on their way out of the polling place. And remind them that we'll be back again in November 2026!
- 2. If we have campaign literature on the table, feel free to offer it to voters AFTER they've voted, to share with friends and neighbors. Do NOT try to put any material in their hands.
- 3. Do NOT engage in a political discussion or debate. Our role as greeters is to express appreciation. Just smile and say, "I'm glad you came out to vote."
- 4. Please stay 50 feet from the entrance of the polling place.
- 5. If you wear anything with a candidate/political message, and need to enter the polling place, please cover up before you go inside. Also have a spare windbreaker or sweater you can lend to a voter who might be turned away for wearing attire with a political message.
- 6. You may want to bring a chair for times when voting is light (I hope there won't be too many light periods).

Please watch out for Voter Intimidation. (See	e next page.)

Voter intimidation includes:

- Individual or group harassment and threats
- Blocking people from getting in line
- Forcing people out of line after closing time. If you're in line when polls close, you do get to vote.
- Spreading misinformation that certain people aren't eligible to vote (e.g., "You must speak English to vote" or "You must have paid all your child support before you can vote", or "You need a photo ID to vote.")
- Videotaping or photographing individuals in line
- General hostilities

If you see any action that impairs a person's right to vote or that makes you uncomfortable you can bring it to the attention of your ED Captain if he/she is there. If he or she is not there, you can call: 1833-DELDEMS (335-3367)
