

PS 151Q CEP Goals 2025-2026 School Year

- 1.By June 2026, all second grade students scoring at or above benchmark will improve 5%, from 49% to 54% as measured by Oral Reading fluency on Acadience Benchmark Test.
- 2. By June 2026, all students in Grades 3-5 will improve by 5%, from 50 to 55%, in the Comprehension: Information Domain on the i-Ready ELA Diagnostic.
- 3. By June 2026, the average overall performance of ELLs and SWIEPs in grades 3-5 scoring Tier 1 on the ELA Diagnostic will improve by 7%, from 29% to 35%.
- 4.By June 2026, physical and mental wellness for all students will improve, as measured by a decrease of three Level 1 incidents, from 10 to 7, as measured by the Online Occurrence Reporting System Report.
- 5. PS 151Q will address Priority 3: All students have a high quality academic experience with the following SMART Goal: By June 2026, the percentage of all Grade 1 and 2 students scoring in Tier 1 in mathematics will increase by 5%, from 39.5 to 45%, as measured by the i-Ready Math Diagnostic
- 6. PS 151Q will address Priority 3: All students have a high quality academic experience with the following SMART Goal: By June 2026, the percentage of ELLS in grades 3-5 scoring in Tier 1 will increase by 5% from 39.3% to 44%, as measured by the i-Ready Math Diagnostic.
- 7. PS 151Q will address Priority 3: All students have a high quality academic experience with the following SMART Goal: By June 2026, the percentage of SWIEPs in grades 3-5 scoring in Tier 1 will increase by 5% from 20.3% to 25%, as measured by the i-Ready Math Diagnostic.



- 8. SMART Goal: By June 2026, the percentage of first grade students with active NYCKids RISE College Savings accounts and completing Building Block 1 will increase by 10%, from 40% to 50%, as measured by the Save for College InfoHub.
- 9. PS 151Q will address Priority 5: All districts and schools are more inclusive and responsive for Parents of Students with Disabilities (SWIEP) with the following SMART Goal: By June 2026, the percentage of parents indicating they are satisfied that their child is achieving their IEP goals will Increase by 3%, from 92% to 95%, as measured by NYC Family School Survey.
- 10. By June 2026, the daily attendance for all students will increase by 1%, from 92 to 93%, as measured by the Insight Attendance Report.
- 11. By June 2026, to strengthen the quality and implementation of IEPs for SWIEPs, we will increase the percentage of SWIEPs performing at or above grade level, from 23.3% to 28% on the i-Ready ELA diagnostic.
- 12. By June 2026, to strengthen the quality and implementation of IEPs for SWIEPs, we will increase parent voice/concerns on the IEP by 89%, from 11% to 100%, as measured by the IEP Review.
