We seek women applicants who demonstrate exceptional academic achievement with an **SRJC GPA of 3.5 or above**. In considering the most qualified candidates, we will look at academic achievement, leadership qualities, a commitment to community and/or experience balancing work/family responsibilities with academic pursuits.

Eligibility Criteria:

- · Applicants must identify as female.
- A minimum cumulative GPA of 3.5 on a 4.0 scale is required from SRJC.
- Intended transfer to a four-year university for the upcoming fall semester.
- Demonstration of leadership qualities through academic, extracurricular, employment, and/or community activities.
- Applicants advancing to Round 2 will be asked to provide contact information for two references and must be available for an in-person interview during the week of May 12th-16th, 2025.

The Saturday Afternoon Club will confer three scholarships, each valued at \$1,500, to deserving recipients.

Application Process:

Interested candidates must submit their applications online or postmarked by mail no later than April 30, 2025. Applications received after this date or found incomplete will not be considered.

Notification and Interview Process:

Finalists selected for **Round 2** consideration will be notified during the week of May 5-9, 2025, asked to **provide contact information for two references**, and scheduled for an **in-person interview** between May 12th-16th. Winners will be announced by May 23, 2025.

Verification of GPA and college transfer status will be required prior to the disbursement of award funds.

Note: All applications will be reviewed to ensure compliance with our guidelines. All submissions will be scanned for Al-generated text. If applicants utilize Al-generated text in their submissions, they are encouraged to disclose this information, along with the extent and purpose of its use.
