NATIONS MOST ABLE TO ACCEPT CLIMATE REFUGEES IN THE FUTURE June 2020

This is a list of the nations with the least density of population, which are most capable of accepting large numbers of refugees as global warming gets worse. This list is based on relative population density. However, nations are not included in this list if they are almost entirely desert (which make those lands unsuitable for large numbers of additional humans), or are mostly rainforests (which should be returned to nature to regenerate the world's climate and environment).

Nations with the most potential to accept climate refugees, in the order of least density, are:

Conversely, the nations which have the highest population density and are most likely to export climate refugees to other nations are, in the order of most severely affected:

Listed after the refugee nation are most likely receiver nations, either based on geographical proximity or language spoken.

Muslim refugees may feel most comfortable moving to low density Islamic nations Kazakhstan, Turkey, Azerbaijan, or Iran.

Russia can provide a great service to the world if it opens Siberia for resettlement especially of South Asians (from overpopulated Bangladesh, India, Sri Lanka), so those abandoned lands can

be returned to reforestation. Russians living in Siberia should be resettled in European Russia or Belarus.
