Message from the West; David Finkelstein

My Brothers,

Last month, I talked about some of the substantive content in the lectures. This month, I will talk about some of hidden items in the lectures, what animators and movie folks call "Easter Eggs". If you didn't get to look for real Easter Eggs on Easter, you can look for them in the lectures and Degrees.

The first Easter Egg I found years ago while studying the EA lecture, is on page 29 of the Masonic Code (the "red book"). There, the EA lecture tells us that the way we became Masons is reminiscent of this passage in Matthew 7:7-8: "Ask and it shall be given you; seek and you shall find, knock and it shall be opened unto you." The first word of each of those phrases is Ask, Seek, and Knock. And the first letter of each of those words, A-S-K, spells the word "ask." See if you can find other words spelled out by the first letters of words or phrases in the lectures or degrees. If you find one, let me know.

Another type of Easter Egg starts on page 33 of the EA lecture. There, the EA lecture explains many of the parts of all Lodges. The Easter Egg is that it goes in order, spatial order. It starts with the Supports of Lodge. Then it goes UP to the Covering of a Lodge. Then back DOWN HALF-WAY

to the furniture on the altar (the Holy Bible, Square and Compasses). Then it goes DOWN ALL THE WAY to the floor, specifically, the Mosaic pavement and the indented tessel. After that, it SPREADS OUT to the three principal officers of the Lodge and the ashlars on the ground next to the WM. Then, it SPREADS OUT EVEN FURTHER to the entire Lodge (in a discussion of the direction in which the Lodge is situated). Listen for that the next time you hear the EA lecture.

Yet another type of Easter Egg is a hidden meaning. Page 43 of the EA lecture compares the elements, and refers to there being only four elements, Earth, Wind, Fire and Water. Now, by 1661, mankind knew that there were more than 4 elements; today, we know there are 118. What does this strange reference to their only being 4 elements hide? That the EA lecture is at least 359 years old? That Masonry is at least 359 years old? Or is it one of Masonry's famous allegories, something that stands for something else?

Another example of the "hidden meaning Easter Egg" yields similar questions with even older ages. At page 95 of the MM lecture, it discusses the usefulness of astronomy. There, it says astronomy assists us in ascertaining "the power by which the planets circulate in their orbs." This is a reference to model of the cosmos that said that the motion of the sun, planets and stars was due to movement of large spheres (or "orbs") that rotated around Earth with the sun, planets and stars embedded in them. But this theory was debunked in 1577. Perhaps this is a reference to the MM lecture or Masonry itself being more than 443 years old. Or perhaps, again, this is another allegory, a reference that actually stands for something else.

These are just some of the hidden items in the lectures. While you are stuck in your house, you can spend some quality time with your red book and see if you can find more. Or you can sit in your home and eat too much, like me.
