Message from the South; JW David Finkelstein

I recently had occasion to go to a Lodge where it was past master's night. One Brother was in shorts, a T-shirt and sneakers. He and the Worshipful Master conferred and agreed that it might make the past masters feel a lack of respect if he stayed and so he went home.

I thought about the words from our Entered Apprentice lecture "It is the internal and not the external qualifications of a man that recommend him to be a Mason". How did having a dress code comport with those words? Very simply, my Brothers. Those words are symbols, meant to communicate that we treat each other equally. They were not words of instruction on how you should dress.

We use words as symbols just like we use physical objects as symbols. We can understand clearly that when we refer to a physical object in Masonry, we are not referring to the actual object, but rather, what the object stands for. It's a little harder to recognize that Masonry's words often don't actually refer to what the words say, but what those words stand for.

When we say it's "High Twelve," we are referring to "break time", not "noon", even though that's what the words "High Twelve" would normally mean. Masonry has used the words "High Twelve" as a symbol, not for its literal meaning.

Perhaps the most important place to recognize that Masonry uses words as symbols is in the penalty for the violation of your obligation. Masonry uses drastic words as symbols that mean "we really don't want you to violate your obligation." Masonry does not use those words for their literal meaning.

So it is with "It is the internal and not the external qualifications of a man that recommend him to be a Mason". The meaning of those words would be "we don't care what you wear". But Masonry is not using those words for their literal meaning. Masonry is using those words as a symbol that that says "treat all men equally." So don't wear a T-shirt to Lodge.
