Our POST 16 Offers -

We offer a specially designed post 16 programme to our students. We suggest students attend a minimum of two days a week, however **three days a week for the academic year** is recommended to allow the optimum possibility of gaining all the available qualifications:

Construction -

Our new 'Construction' package offers the following:

- Pearson BTEC Level 1 Introductory in Construction (Award/Certificate/Diploma)
- Functional Skills English
- Functional Skills Maths
- First Aid at Work Qualification
- CSCS Card application
- CITB HS&E test
- 'Live' site visits and real time work experience with local building contractors

This course is perfect for anyone looking to enter the world of construction. Delivered at our Avonmouth site, students will learn the skills and gain the qualifications to allow them to move into employment upon completion.

Vocational Teaching -

Our 'Pre vocational studies' course offers the following:

Construction:

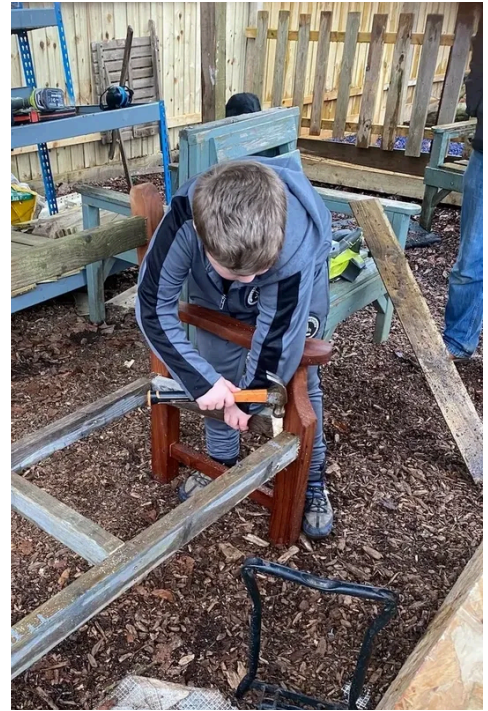

Pricing and timings

Timings of the day can be organised to suit the students needs. Students can be collected from your school/home and transported back to school/home before and after sessions in our private transport which is included.

Part of Post 16 programme however is to help our students establish 'life skills'. Transporting themselves to and from the facilities will be part of this training. Our pricing also includes breakfast and lunch for the students each day.

Pricing:

Our pricing starts @ £285 per student per day (This may change according to individual need).

We do not charge VAT.

We keep our onsite group size purposely low (Maximum of six), and will not overload our sessions. This would have a negative effect on the students learning and the impact we can have as teachers.

Our approach is based on the time and the relationships that we build with our young people, and keeping our numbers low helps us achieve this.
