Our Hospitality BTEC course has been designed in partnership with local cafe and restaurant owners to give our young people the best chance of success upon completion of the course within the hospitality environment.

Getting our students 'work-ready' means that we offer a package that not only contains a BTEC first in Hospitality, but other relevant vocational qualifications. The course includes:



- BTEC Level 1 Introductory in Hospitality and Tourism
- BTEC level 1 & 2 Award in Home Cooking Skills
- First aid at work
- Food hygiene level 2
- Allergen Awareness
- Hazard Analysis and Critical Control Point (HACCP) Level 2

As with all our post 16 courses, Discovery Education covers:

- All course entry fees
- Transport to and from the centre each day
- Food each day
- All course materials needed
- A designated 1-2-1 key worker
- Discovery will have representatives at meetings such as annual reviews, emergency reviews etc
- Weekly reports
- Termly update reports covering all achievements and course tracking
