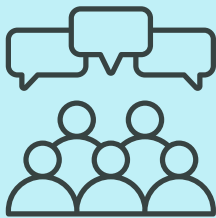

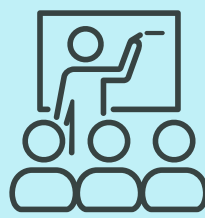
Reflecting on 2025: A Year of Impact and Growth

EDUCATE

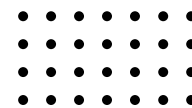

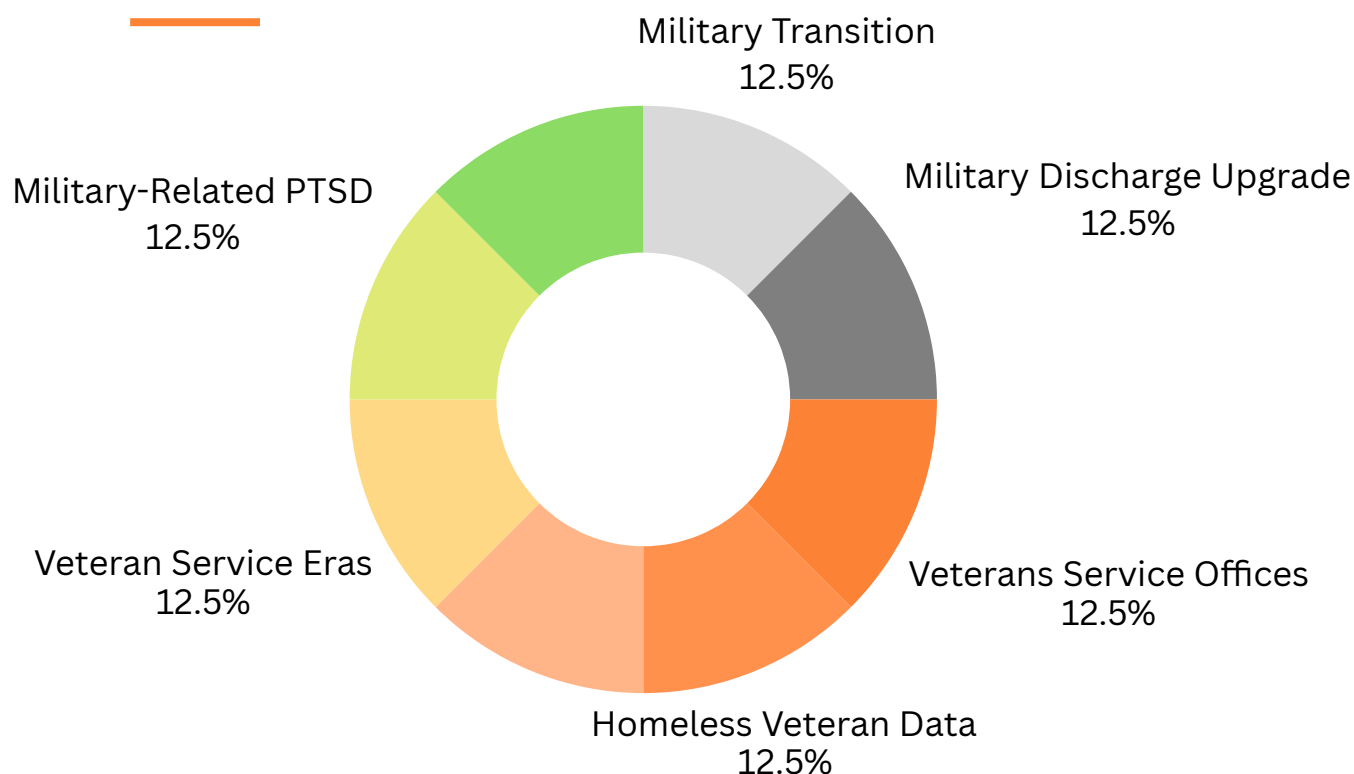
Veteran Connect Research Project (VCRP) 24/25

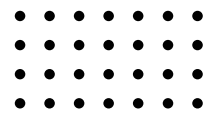

Veteran-Focused Topics



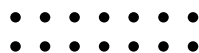
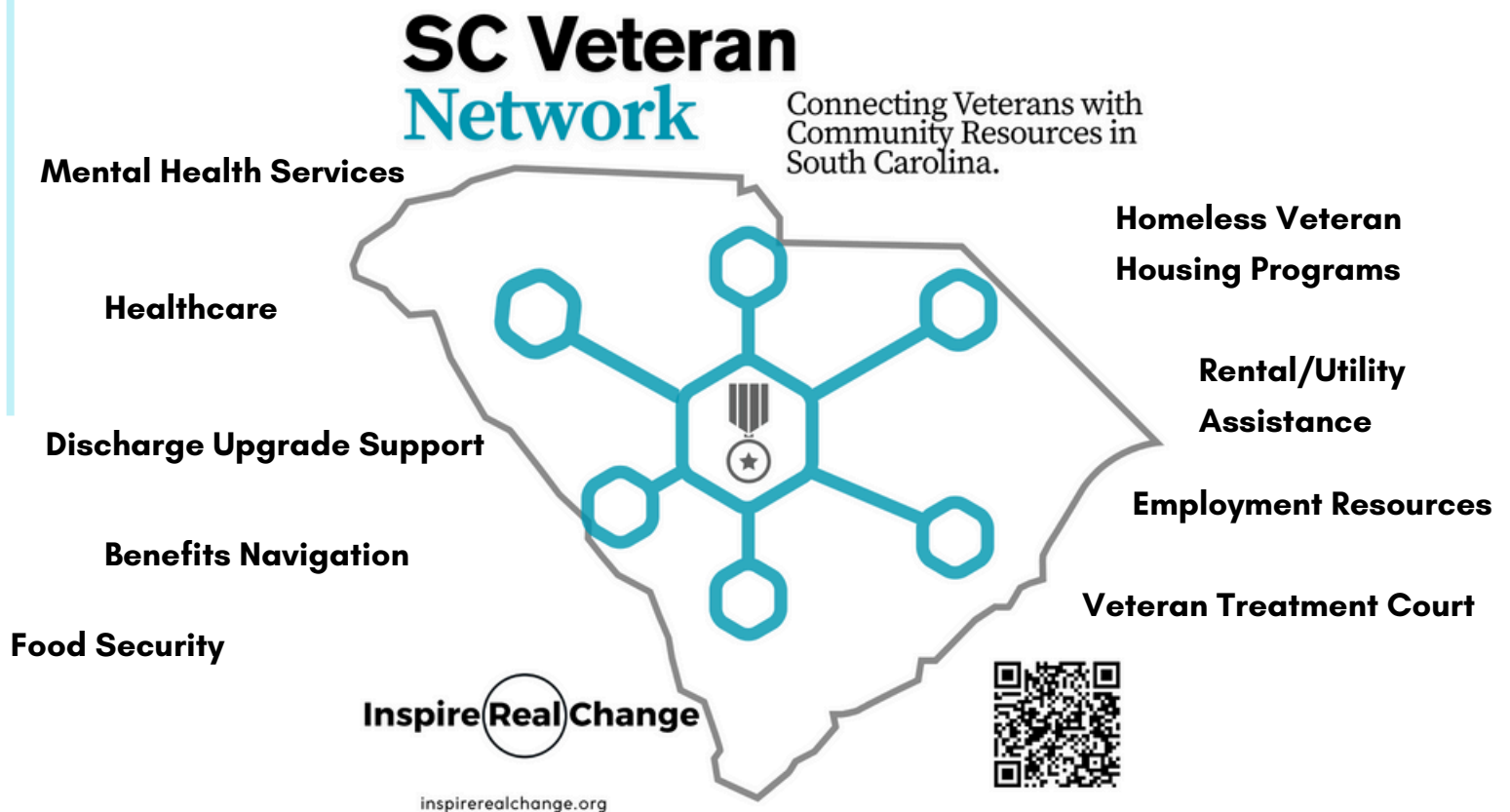

SC Veteran Network



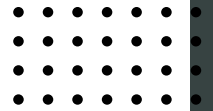
Through research initiatives, Inspire Real Change identified that many Veterans across South Carolina face barriers in accessing information about the supportive resources available to them. In response, the organization reinvented the Veteran Connect Project and established the SC Veteran Network to close this information gap and improve access to care.

Inspire Real Change remains dedicated to addressing the challenges Veterans encounter by providing direct outreach, assessments, and connections to essential services. Through the SC Veteran Network, the organization engages Veterans where they are—on the streets, in shelters, and within communities—to ensure no one is left behind. Veterans and their families can contact Inspire Real Change for personalized guidance and referrals to both Veteran-specific and community-based programs across South Carolina, helping them access housing, healthcare, employment, and other critical supports.

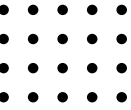

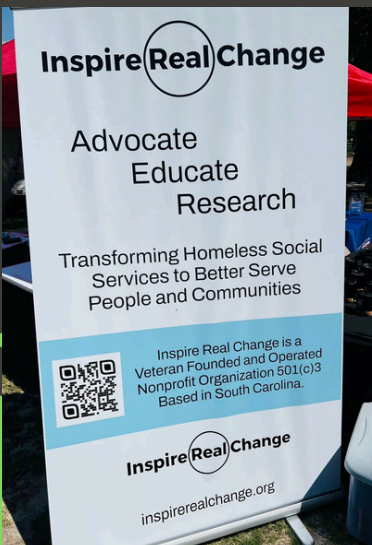
