



BSTD Registration Info 2026 - How to get involved

Please note this is not the registration form, competitor declaration form can be found on the last page of the rulebook.

The current rulebook may be downloaded from the website (<u>www.scurryandtrials.co.uk</u>) or requested by email, post or telephone.

The registration period runs from 1st January – 31st December in the same year.

You must abide by rules detailed in the Official BSTD rule book ©

All competitors must be bound by the BEF Equine Anti-Doping and Controlled Medication Rules and the BEF Anti-Doping rules for Human Athletes. Copies of this can be found at www.bef.co.uk, and are amended from time to time.

Competitors must source their own **personal public liability insurance for competing in timed events.**

Those registering must send all relevant documents before they drive at their first event.

Novice drivers may only stay in the novice league for a maximum of two years, or at the discretion of the organisers. Full details of novice criteria can be found in the rule book.

The registration process

- 1) A copy of the competitor's public liability insurance which covers timed events
- 2) A signed copy of the competitor declaration form at the end of the current rulebook
- 4) The correct fee which must be paid via BACS or cheque

Type of Registration	Payment
Open Driver	£55
Novice Driver	£30
Supporter	£20

If paid before 31st December, open fee becomes £45.

If paid before 31st January, open fee becomes £50 and novice fee becomes £25.
