Saturday, June 22nd, 10am-4pm

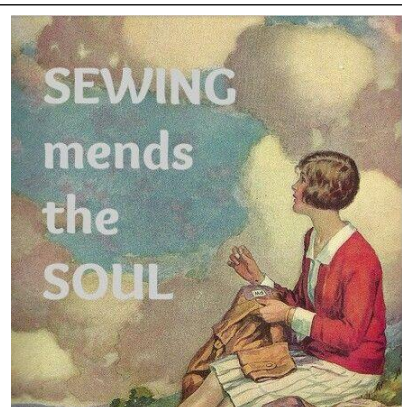
Guy B. Woodward Museum, 645 Main Street, Ramona
