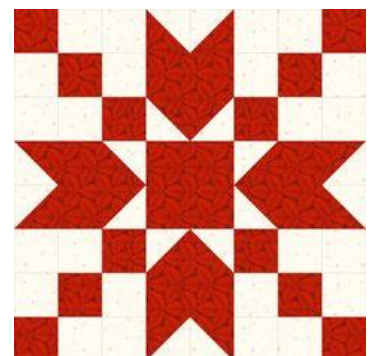

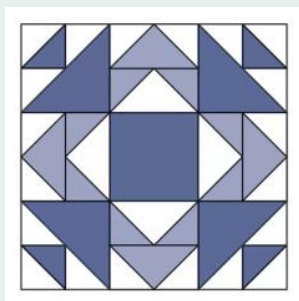

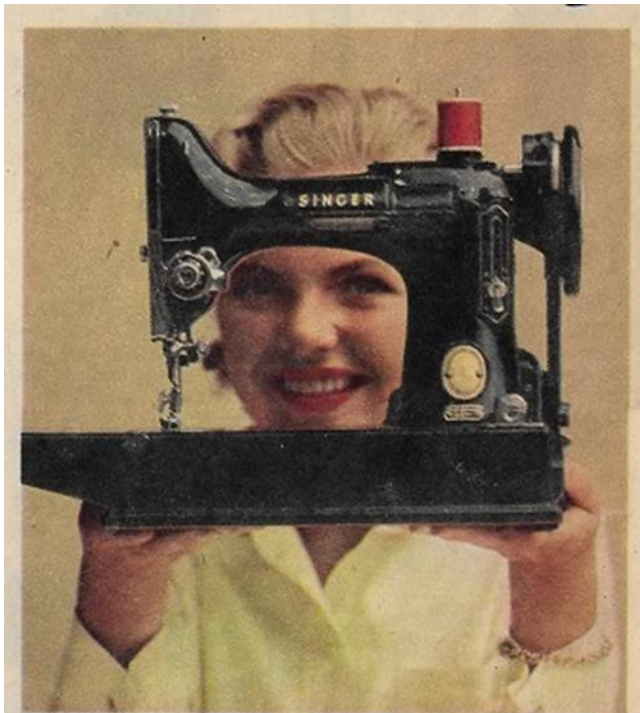

2026 KALEIDOSCOPE QUILT GUILD CHALLENGE

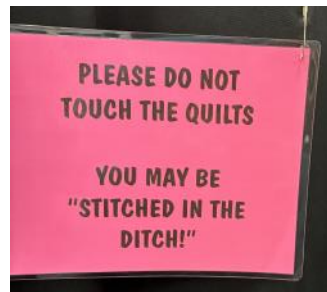
PLEASE DON'T TOUCH THE QUILTS!

Here are some ideas

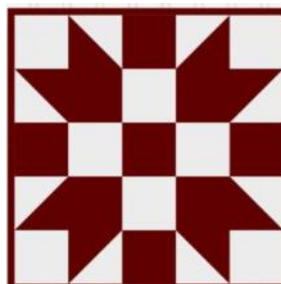
