2021 Victory Challenge

Kaleidoscope Quilt Guild

Get your creative juices flowing! You are talented and everyone in the guild wants to see your work! Join us in this challenge!

The theme for the challenge is Victory! Choose one of the blocks below, either pieced or applique, and interpret them anyway you wish. (For instance, the appliqué block may represent being home, or the home sweet homestead during the Pandemic.) Be creative! Use the block repetitively or combined with others (including the other block below)! Any size or color can be used.

If it helps you to be committed to completing the challenge, send your name to Lori King at quiltengineer04@gmail.com or 619-857-8888 (Kevin's cell phone) or Patty Lawrence at patty2665@aol.com or 619-434-5365 and tell us that you want to commit to the 2021 Victory Challenge.

Size: Minimum 10 inches x 10 inches and a maximum of 70 inches x 70 inches. But, you don't have to be square! (Although, you can be if you want. 😊) Ideally, use a table runner size (standard is 1/3 the table width by the table length + 12") or use a lap quilt size (standard is 50" x 60").

Due Date: Sunday, October 10, 2021. Deliver to Peggy Couvrette's house, during the day. Quilts must be finished and will be displayed in the 2021 Kaleidoscope Quilt Show.

Prize ribbons will be awarded based on voting for the favorite during the Kaleidoscope Quilt Show. Recognition of ribbon winners will be in the November newsletter.

I will be calling the Veterans Home in Chula Vista soon, to get an update on when they can start receiving quilts. I still have a stack of quilts that I am saving for them.





