Kellie Pomeroy will be teaching a Rosemary West design "Dry Brush Rooster". The surface size is 8 1/2" x 11". It can be painted on metal, wood, or surface of your choice. It can be resized to fit your surface.

design is painted in Jo Sonja paints—which Kellie will supply for a donation to her tip jar.

#### **Tomato Tortellini Soup**

Recipe came from Kathy Prewitt and her sister Denise

- 1 lg onion chopped
- 2-3 tablespoons crushed garlic
- 3 Tablespoons oil
- 2 cans 14 oz. can chicken broth
- 3 cans 14oz. Chopped Italian style tomatoes
- 1 11oz can V-8 juice
- 3 cups thinly sliced Italian or yellow squash
- 1-2 pkgs. fresh tortellini
- 2-3 tablespoons Italian seasoning
- Salt/ pepper
- 2 bunches of fresh basil thinly sliced or chopped
- 2-3 tablespoons balsamic vinegar

In large soup pot sauté onion and garlic in oil until soft. Add tomatoes, broth, juice, heat until boiling add remaining ingredients cook until tortellini and squash are tender 15-20 minutes serve with a good Parmesan cheese.

#### TORTILLA SOUP (Joni Brooks)

1/2 cup chopped onion 2 cloves minced garlic

2 T oil 8 oz can chopped green chilies

1 can Green Giant Shoe Peg Corn (regular corn can be used)

1 16oz can Mexican style diced tomatoes 4 cups chicken broth (I use 8 cups)

1 tsp each, Lemon pepper, chili powder and ground cumin. (Omit cumin if you don't want it hot).

2 tsp Worcheshire sauce 1/2

1/2 tsp Tabasco sauce

1/2 bunch fresh cilantro chopped (do not use dried)

1 Precooked chicken boned. (Store bought rotisserie kind) I also roast my own chicken pieces to save money).

Cook onion and garlic in soup pot until soft. Add chili's, corn, tomatoes and juice in cans, broth, cut up chicken, cilantro and spices. Simmer 15 minutes or longer. Put Fritos in bottom of bowl, then soup on top with cheese and green onions. I use pepper jack cheese.
