



Top Camping Destinations in Himachal Pradesh

1. Spiti Valley – Cold Desert Camping

- **Best for:** Stargazing, unique landscapes, offbeat vibes
- **Popular spots:** Chandra Tal, Kaza, Dhankar, Tabo
- **Season:** May to September
- **Experience:** High-altitude desert camping near the lake or monasteries under clear skies

2. Tirthan Valley – Riverside Bliss

- **Best for:** Peaceful riverside camping and trout fishing
- **Popular spots:** Gushaini, Shoja, Jibhi
- **Season:** March to June, September to November
- **Experience:** Dense forest trails, waterfalls, and cozy camps along the river

3. Parvati Valley – Hippie Camping

- **Best for:** Backpackers, music lovers, and nature seekers
- **Popular spots:** Kasol, Tosh, Kheerganga, Chalal
- **Season:** March to June, September to November
- **Experience:** Hot springs at Kheerganga, night bonfires, music, and stunning trails

4. Triund – The Classic Himalayan Camp

- **Best for:** First-timers and short treks
- **Location:** Near Mcleodganj (Dharamshala)
- **Season:** March to June, September to December
- **Experience:** Sunset views of Dhauladhar Range, campfire evenings on a ridge

5. Chandratul Lake – Moonlit Magic

- **Best for:** High-altitude camping and photography
- **Location:** Lahaul-Spiti (near Kunzum Pass)
- **Season:** June to September
- **Experience:** Camp beside the crescent-shaped lake, one of the most scenic in India

6. Sangla & Chitkul – Last Village of India

- **Best for:** Valley camping near rivers and apple orchards
- **Location:** Kinnaur District
- **Season:** April to October
- **Experience:** Views of Baspa River, the Indo-Tibetan border, and Himalayan peaks

7. Mashobra & Shali Tibba – Secluded Forest Camping

- **Best for:** Forest walks and mountain views without the crowds
- **Location:** Near Shimla
- **Season:** Year-round (except peak snowfall)
- **Experience:** Pine-covered landscapes, ideal for group/family camping

8. Jalori Pass – Hidden Gem

- **Best for:** Nature enthusiasts and offbeat trekkers
- **Location:** Between Kullu and Shimla districts
- **Season:** April to November
- **Experience:** Camping near Serolsar Lake and Himalayan wildlife



Tips for Camping in Himachal:

- Always **check weather conditions** before camping.
- Avoid camping in monsoon (July-August) due to landslides.
- Carry **warm clothing** even in summer for higher altitudes.

- Respect local culture and **leave no trace**.
