Here is a summary of popular countertop materials with pros and cons to help you choose the right material for your home

Quartz	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Non-porous, resists stains and bacteria - Low maintenance - Consistent color and pattern 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Not heat-proof - Can be expensive - Not suitable for outdoor use
Quartzite	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Natural stone with unique veining - More durable than marble - Heat and scratch resistant 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Must be sealed regularly - Can be costly - Limited color options compared to quartz
Marble	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Elegant, timeless look - Naturally cool surface - High resale appeal 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Scratches and stains easily - High maintenance (sealing required) - Expensive
Granite	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Durable and heat-resistant - Unique, natural patterns - Adds real estate value 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Needs regular sealing - Can crack if improperly installed - Heavy (needs strong support)
Corian	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Seamless installation - Non-porous and easy to clean - Can be repaired if scratched 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Not heat-resistant - Less luxurious look - Can scratch and dent more easily
Butcher Block	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Warm, natural appearance - Great for food prep - Can be refinished over time 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Requires frequent sealing - Susceptible to scratches and stains - Not water-resistant
Concrete	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Modern, industrial aesthetic - Customizable color and shape - Very durable 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Prone to cracking - Needs sealing and waxing - Can be costly due to custom work
Tile	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Inexpensive - Heat and stain resistant - Easy to DIY/replace pieces 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Grout stains and requires maintenance - Uneven surface - Can chip or crack
