## Details

### 1. Ready-to-Assemble (RTA) Cabinets

Examples: IKEA, That Cabinet Company (Dexter/Troy), RTA online retailers

- Michigan Cost Range:
  - Cabinets only: \$114–\$300+ per linear foot
  - Installed: \$100–\$300 per linear foot
  - Total for small kitchen (10–20 LF): \$1,500–\$6,000
- Pros: Affordable, modular, DIY-friendly
- Cons: Requires assembly, limited customization

## 2. Big Box Stores (Stock to Semi-Custom)

Examples: Home Depot, Lowe's, Menards

- Michigan Cost Range:
  - Stock: \$100–\$300/LF installed
  - Semi-custom: \$200–\$500/LF installed
  - Typical install labor: \$69–\$119/LF
- Pros: Convenient, wide availability, bundled install
- Cons: Limited design help, upselling common

## 3. Cabinet Dealers (Semi- to Custom)

Examples: CliqStudios (Ann Arbor), Cabinets Express (Troy), EuroAmerica Design

- Michigan Cost Range:
  - Semi-custom: \$150–\$700/LF installed
  - Medium kitchen (25–35 LF): \$15,000–\$25,000
- Pros: Better materials and design support
- Cons: Longer lead times, higher price

## 4. Custom Cabinet Makers

Examples: Local woodshops, Bakes & Kropp (Plymouth), Amish cabinet makers

- Michigan Cost Range:
  - Custom: \$500–\$1,200+ per LF installed
  - Example: \$385/LF base + \$290/LF wall cabinets
  - Total kitchen: \$10,000–\$40,000+
- Pros: Highest quality, personalized design
- Cons: Expensive, long lead time
