You do not have to submit this document with you proposal. You may include documentation that speaks to the need for your activity to strengthen your proposal.

Needs Assessment (Submit appropriate documentation to demonstrate need with your proposal)	
	Continuing review of changes in quality of care (e.g., chart reviews, audit reports)
	Ongoing census of diagnoses made by physicians on staff (e.g., summary of notes, minutes of meetings)
	Advice from authorities of the field or relevant medical societies (e.g., list of expert names/medical societies AND summary of recommendations)
	Formal or informal surveys of target audience, faculty, or staff (e.g., summary of survey – must relate to education need/topics of interest)
	Discussing in departmental meetings (e.g., summary of meeting minutes – must relate to need/topics of interest)
	Data from peer-reviewed journals, government sources, consensus reports (e.g., abstracts/full journal articles, government produced documents)
	Review of board examinations and/or re-certification requirements  (e.g., board review/update requirements)
	New technology, methods of diagnosis/treatment (e.g., description of new procedure, technology, treatment, etc.)
	Legislative, regulatory, or organizational changes affecting patient care (e.g., copy of the measure/change)
