OUTPATIENT PSYCHIATRIST POSITION

The Washington School of Psychiatry is an independent non-profit post-secondary clinical training program is seeking a dynamically minded psychiatrists for a part-time. Responsibilities include: (1) outpatient psychiatry clinical practice; (2) clinical supervision with psychiatry residents; (3) opportunities for teaching.

Basic Qualifications

Applicants must be board-certified or eligible in General Psychiatry and license eligible in the District of Columbia at the time of appointment.

Description

Psychiatrist/Psychiatric Nurse Practitioner is responsible for the psychiatric evaluation of patients at the Washington School of Psychiatry's Outpatient Clinic and is responsible for the management of psychotropic medication management. Psychiatrist will be expected to serve as an attending for Psychiatry residents.

Essential Functions

1. Conducts initial psychiatric screenings and evaluations, incorporating prior records of psychiatric, medical and social history, within one month of a residential placement.
2. Develops and implements individual medication plans, closely monitoring residents' reactions to courses of treatment.
3. Discusses care plans with residents and monitors conditions and changes in treatment.
4. Conducts psychiatric evaluations of residents annually and as needed.
5. Writes notes and reports on clients and maintains required paperwork.
6. Keeps informed of professional trends and developments through review of professional literature and attendance at seminars and workshops.
7. Performs other related professional duties as assigned by the Executive Director.
8. Monitors lab work related to use of psychotropic medications.
